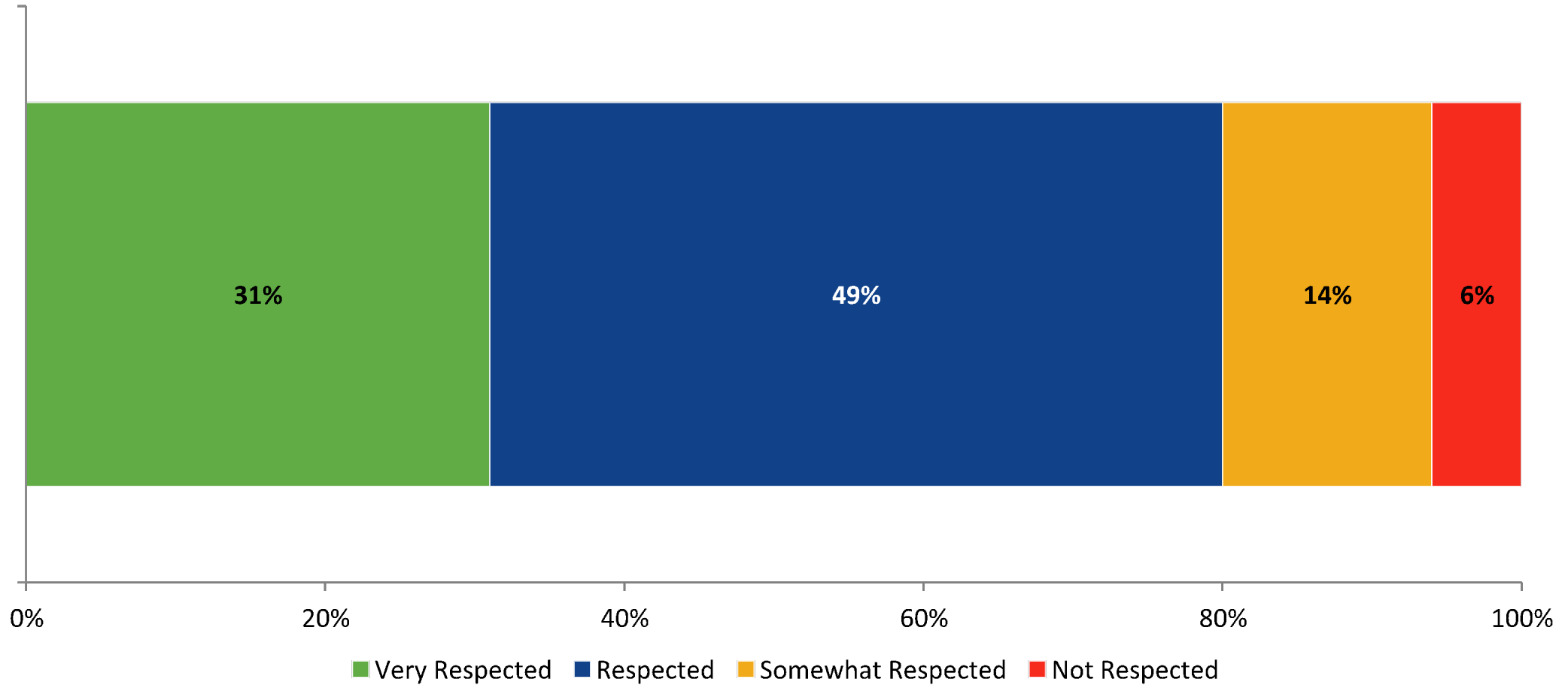

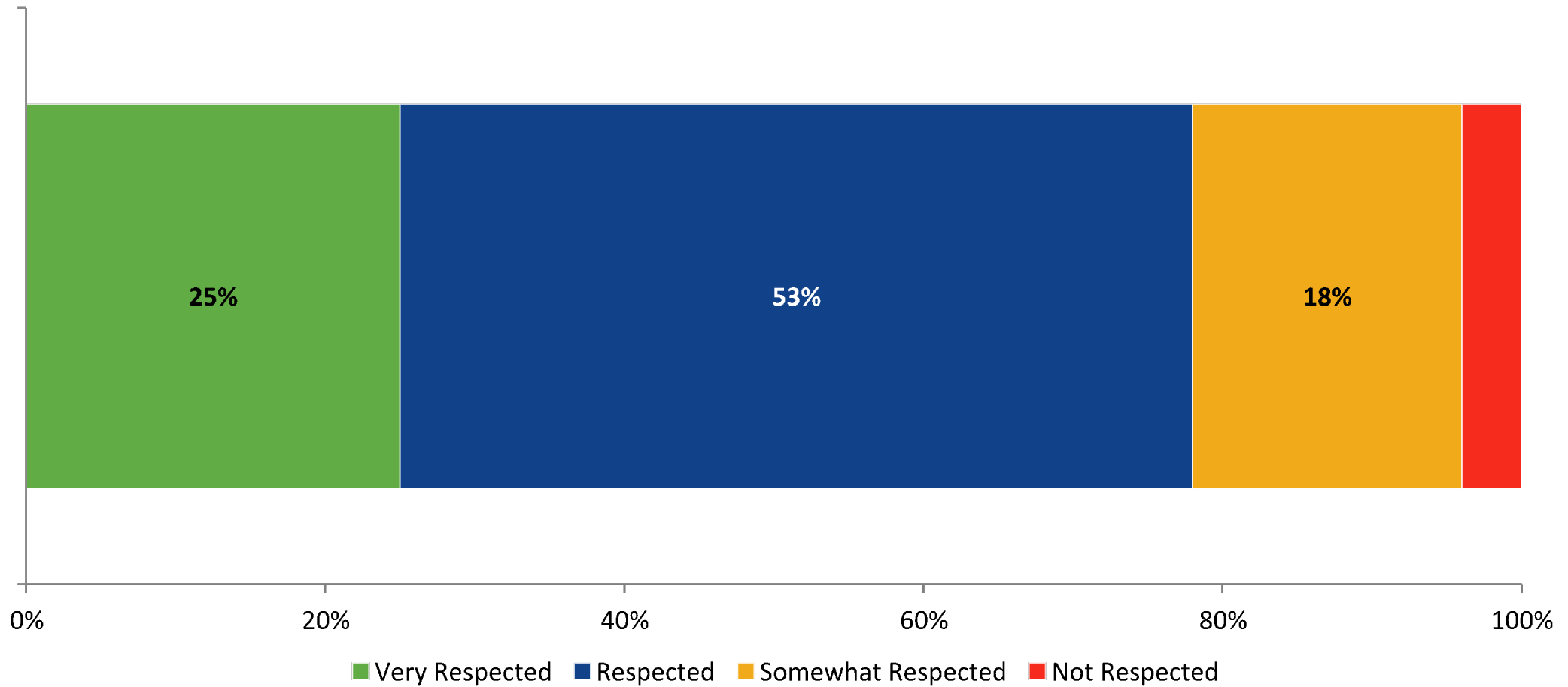
# Feelings of Respect

How respected do you feel at this school? (N=363)

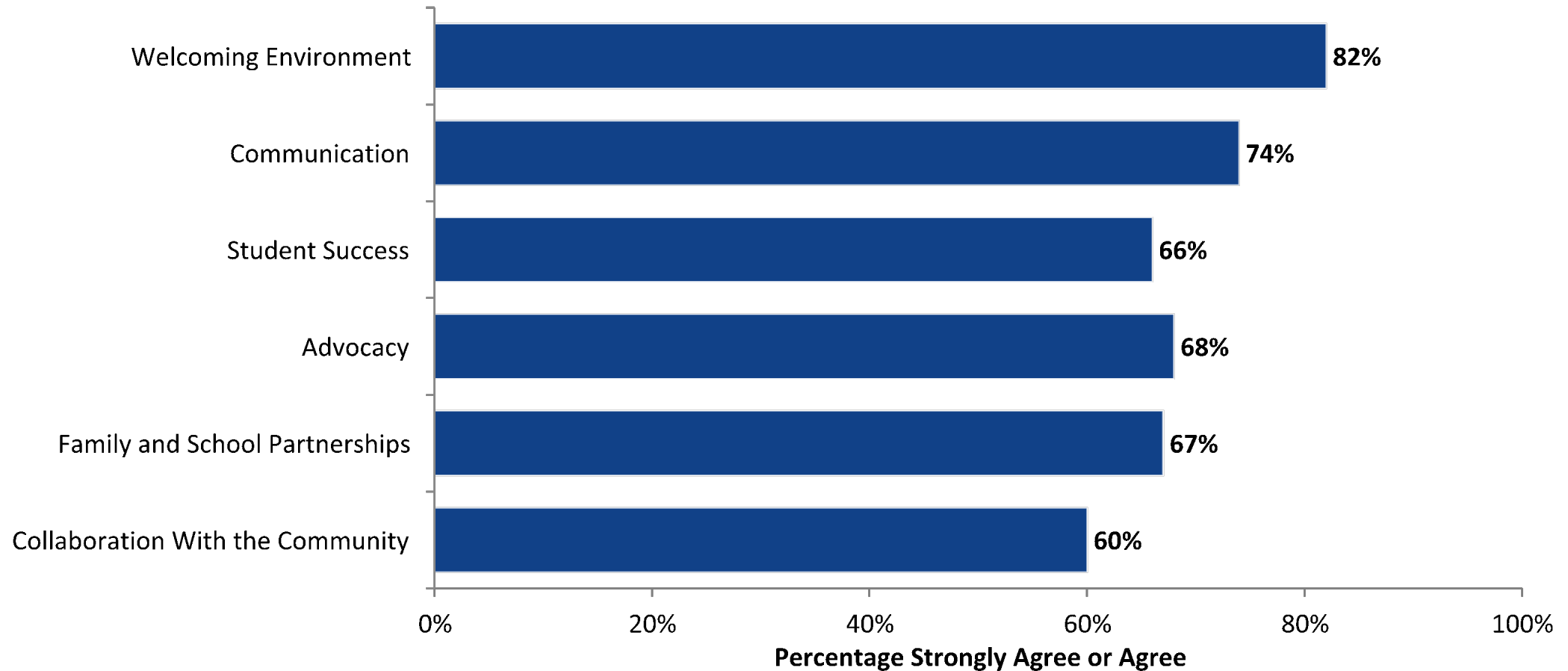

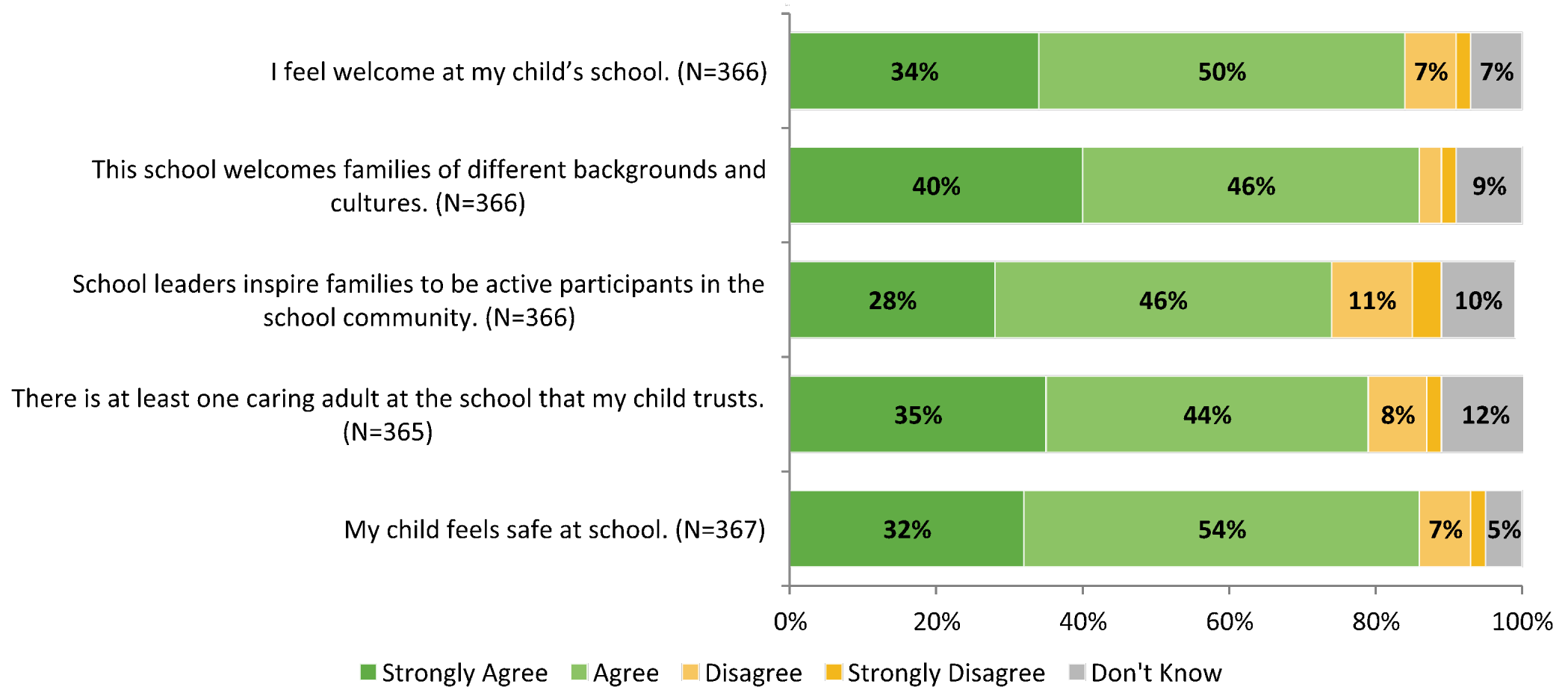

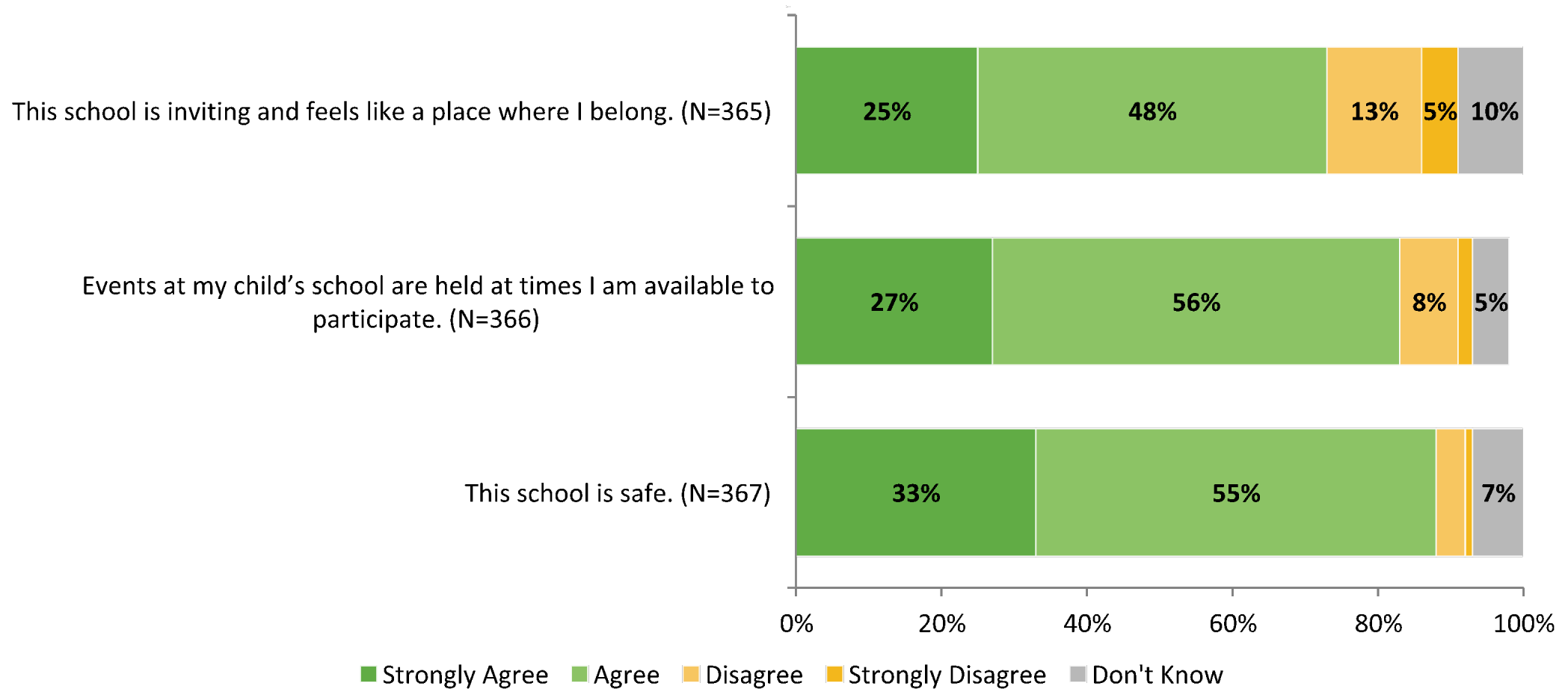

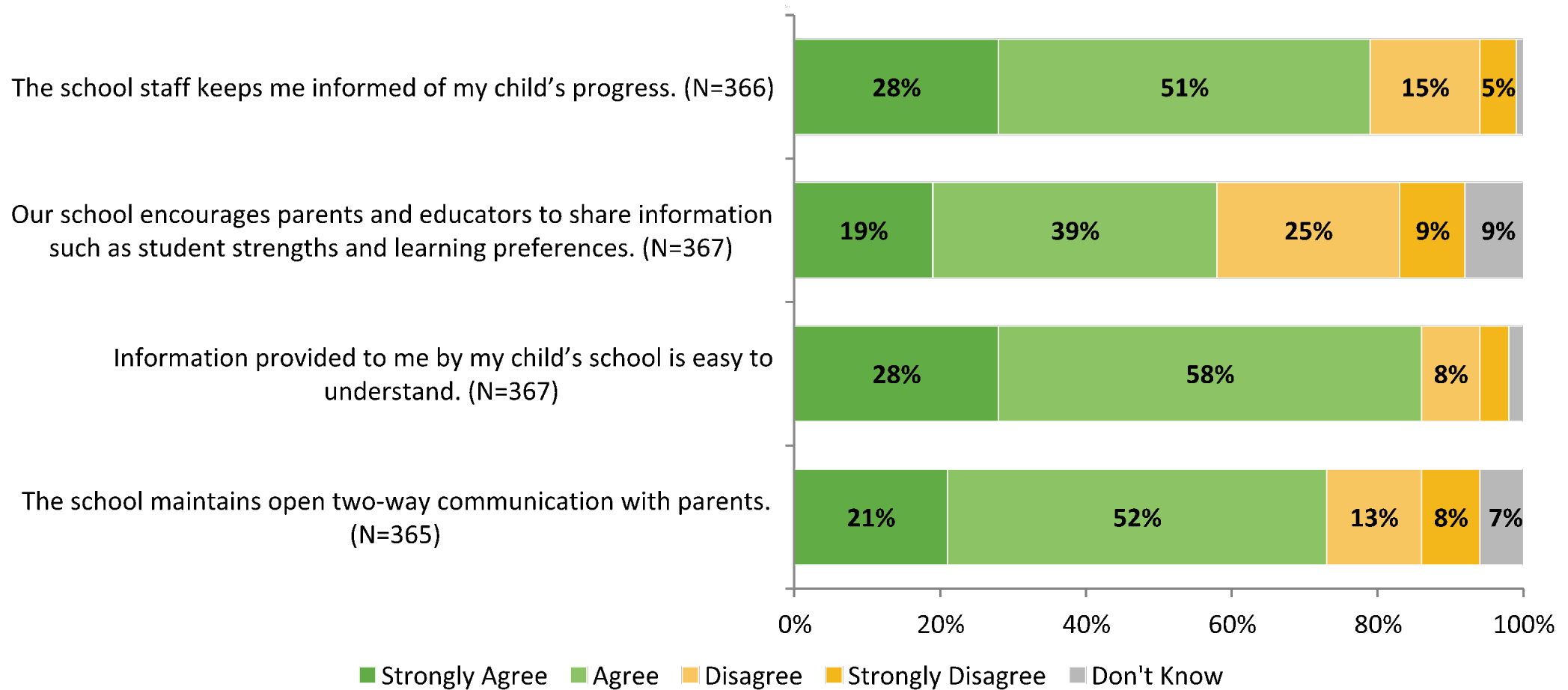

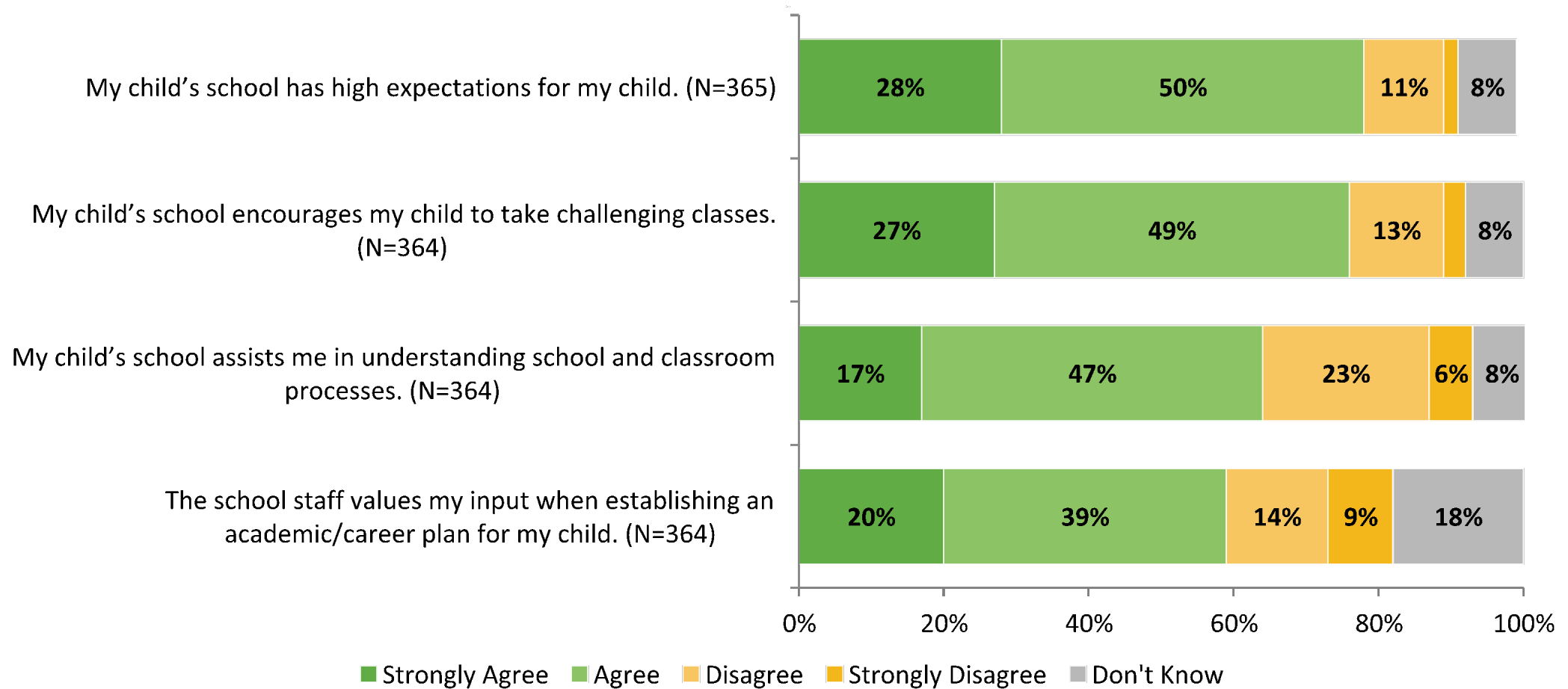

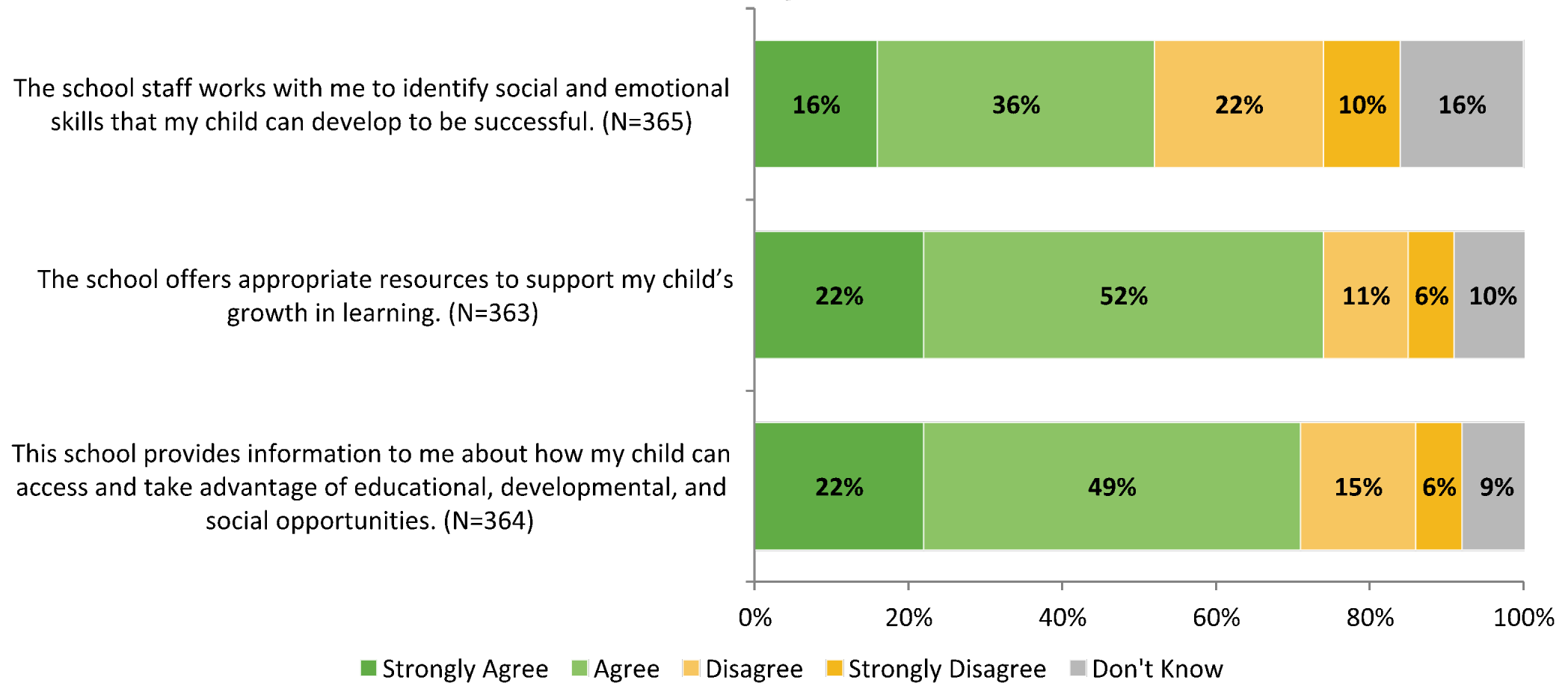

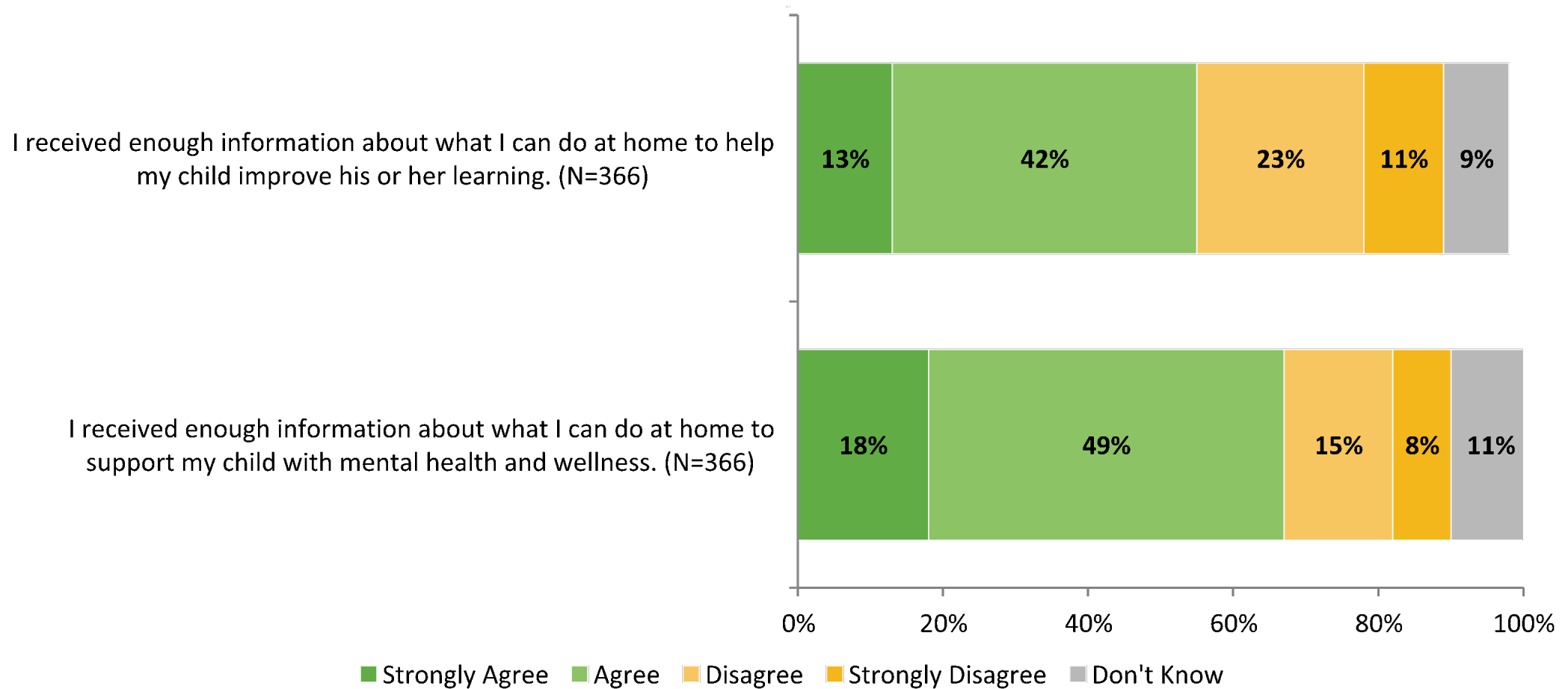

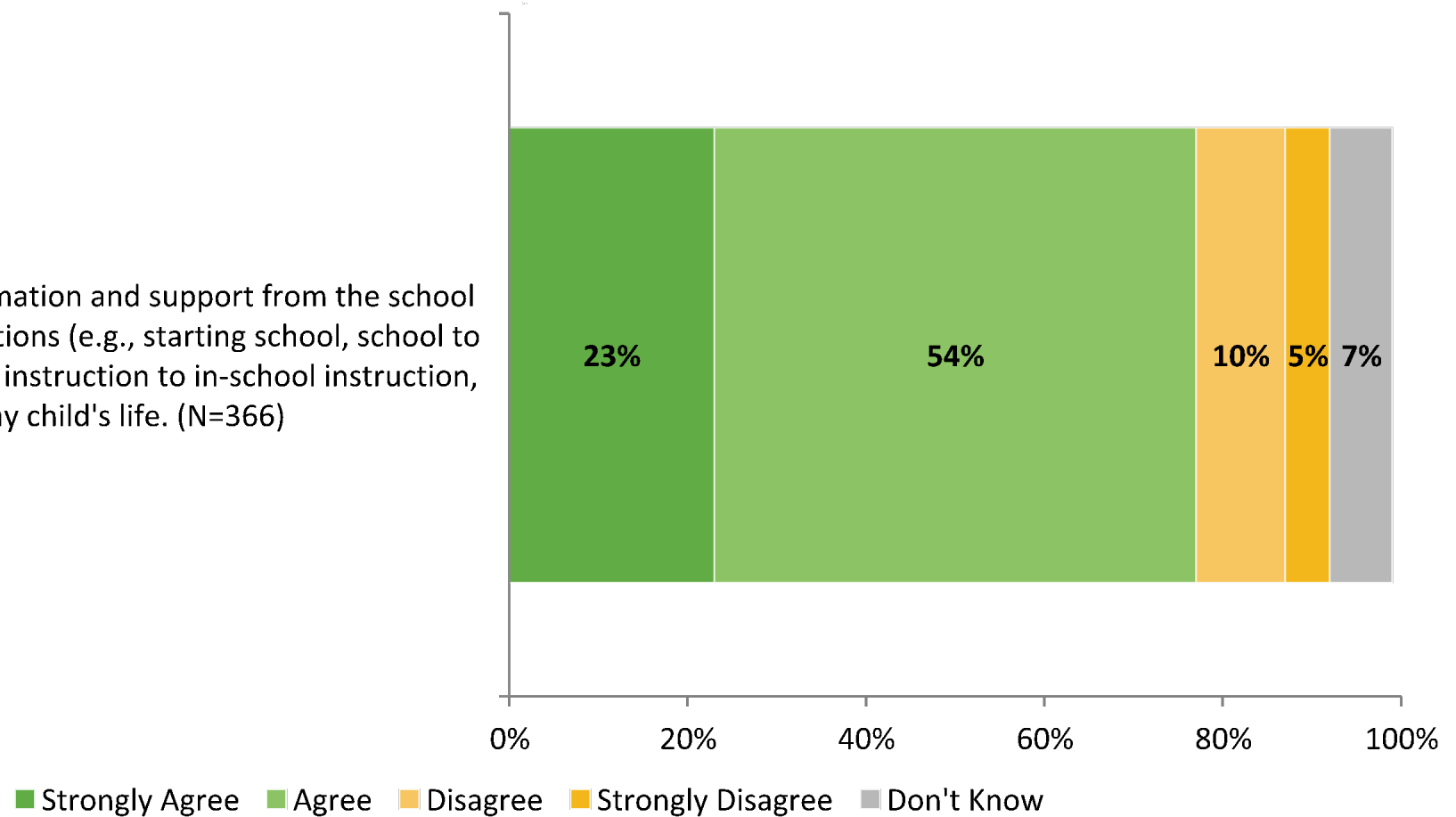

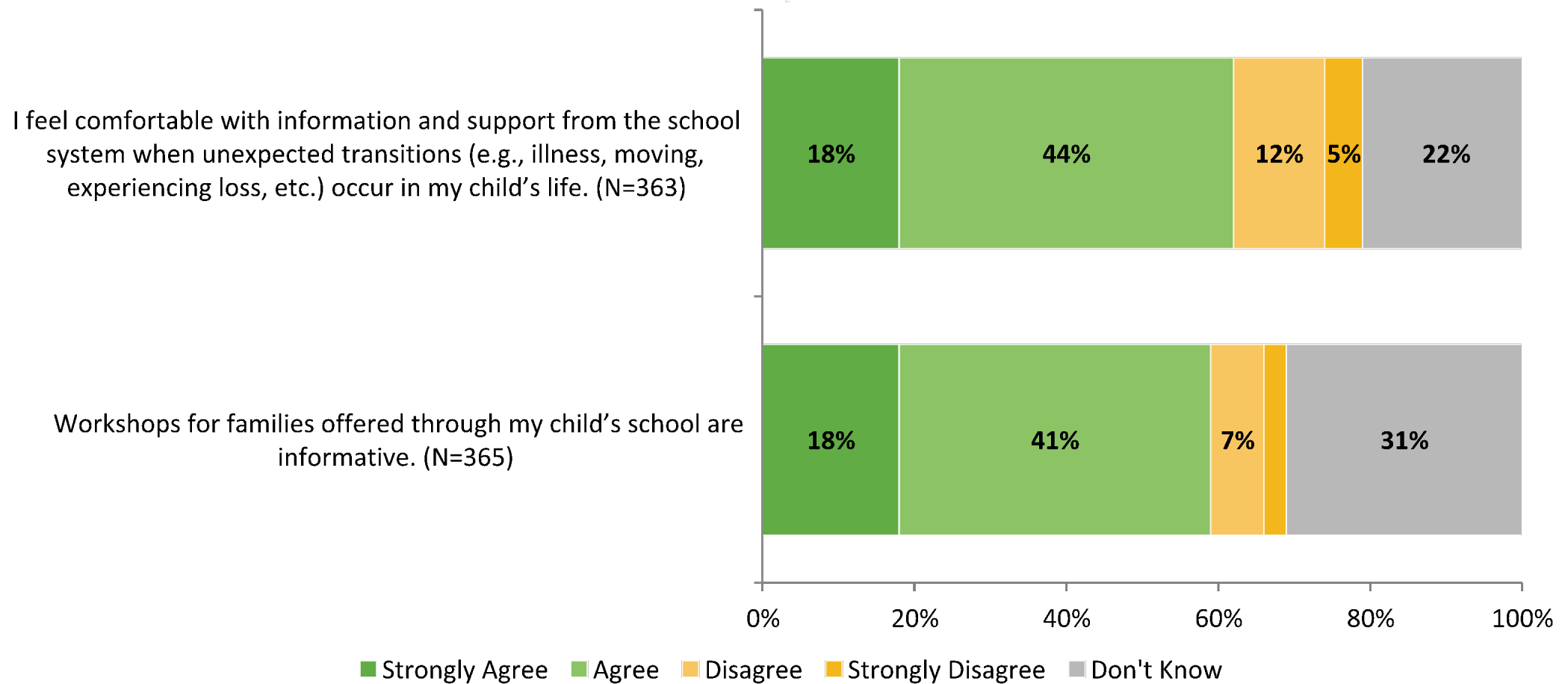

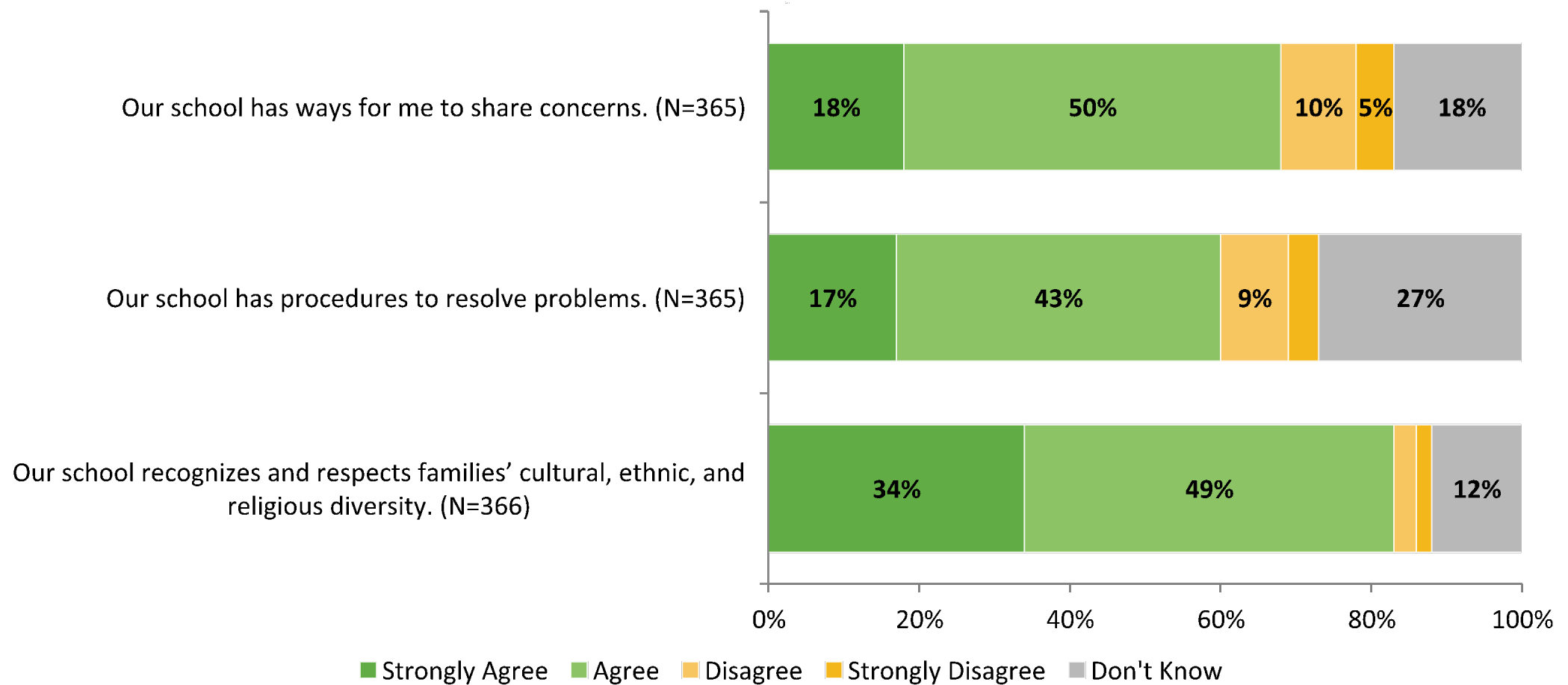

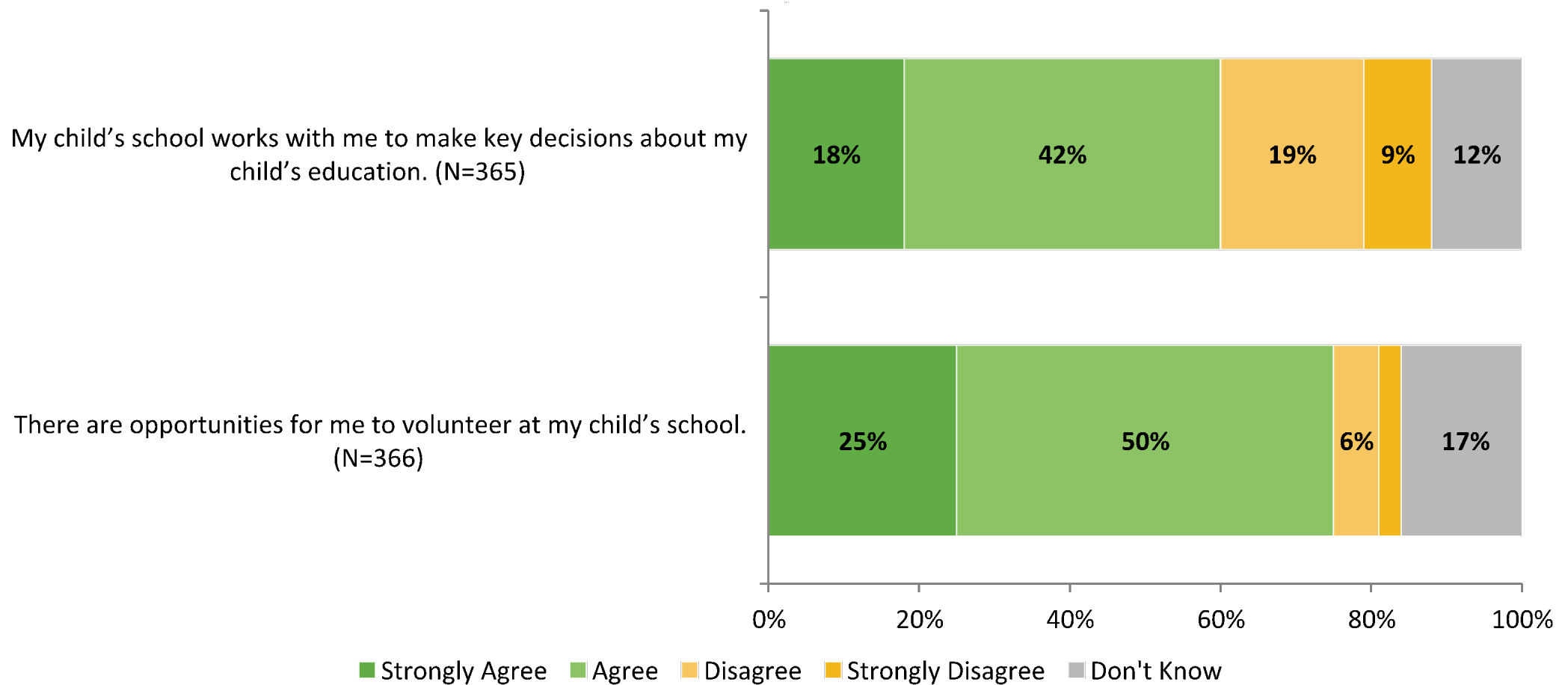

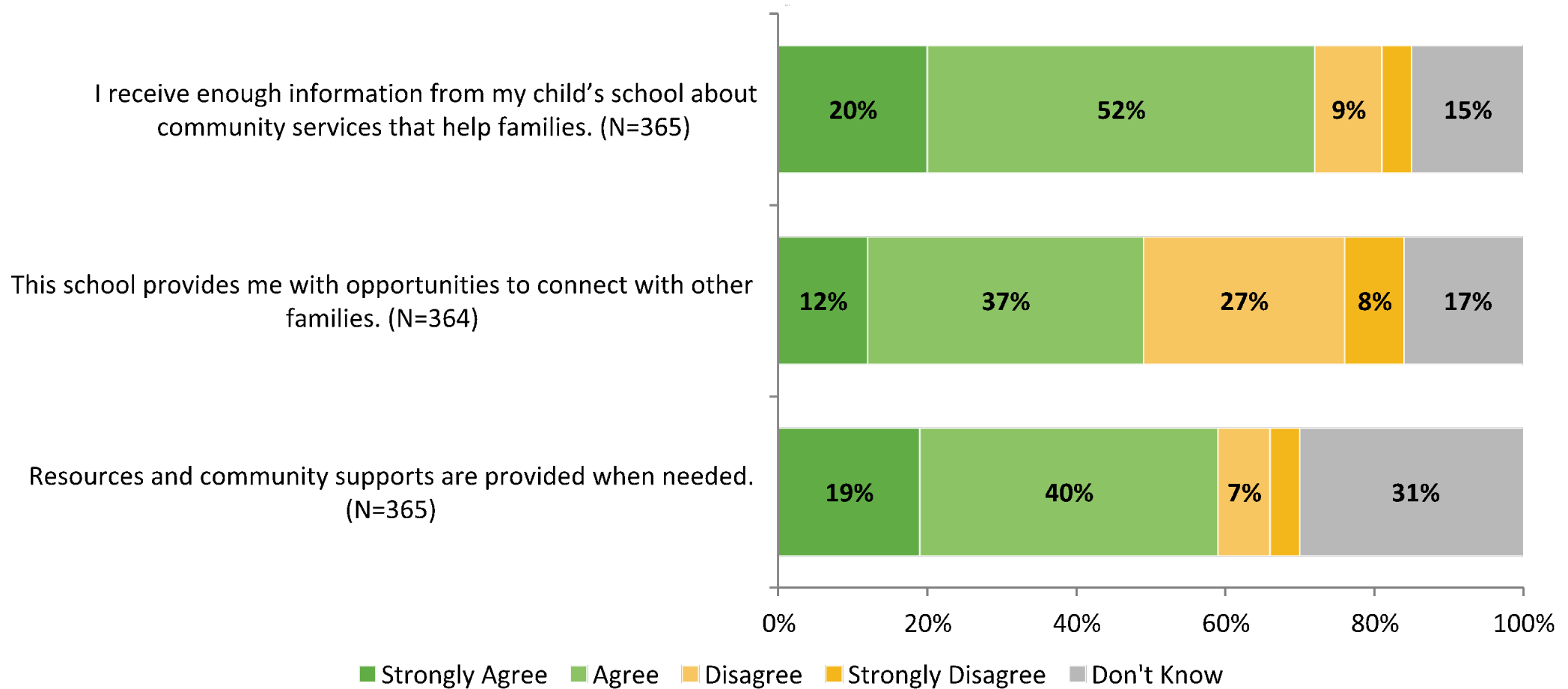

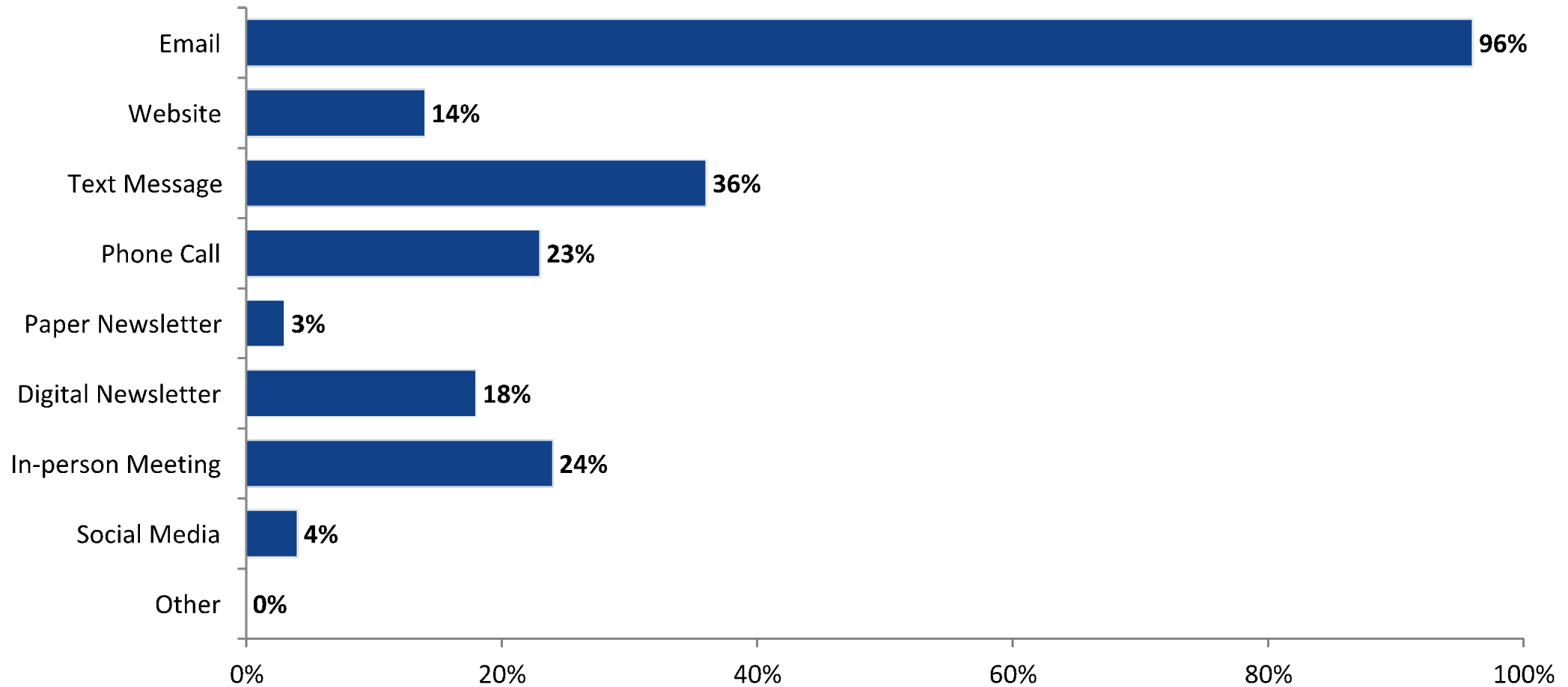

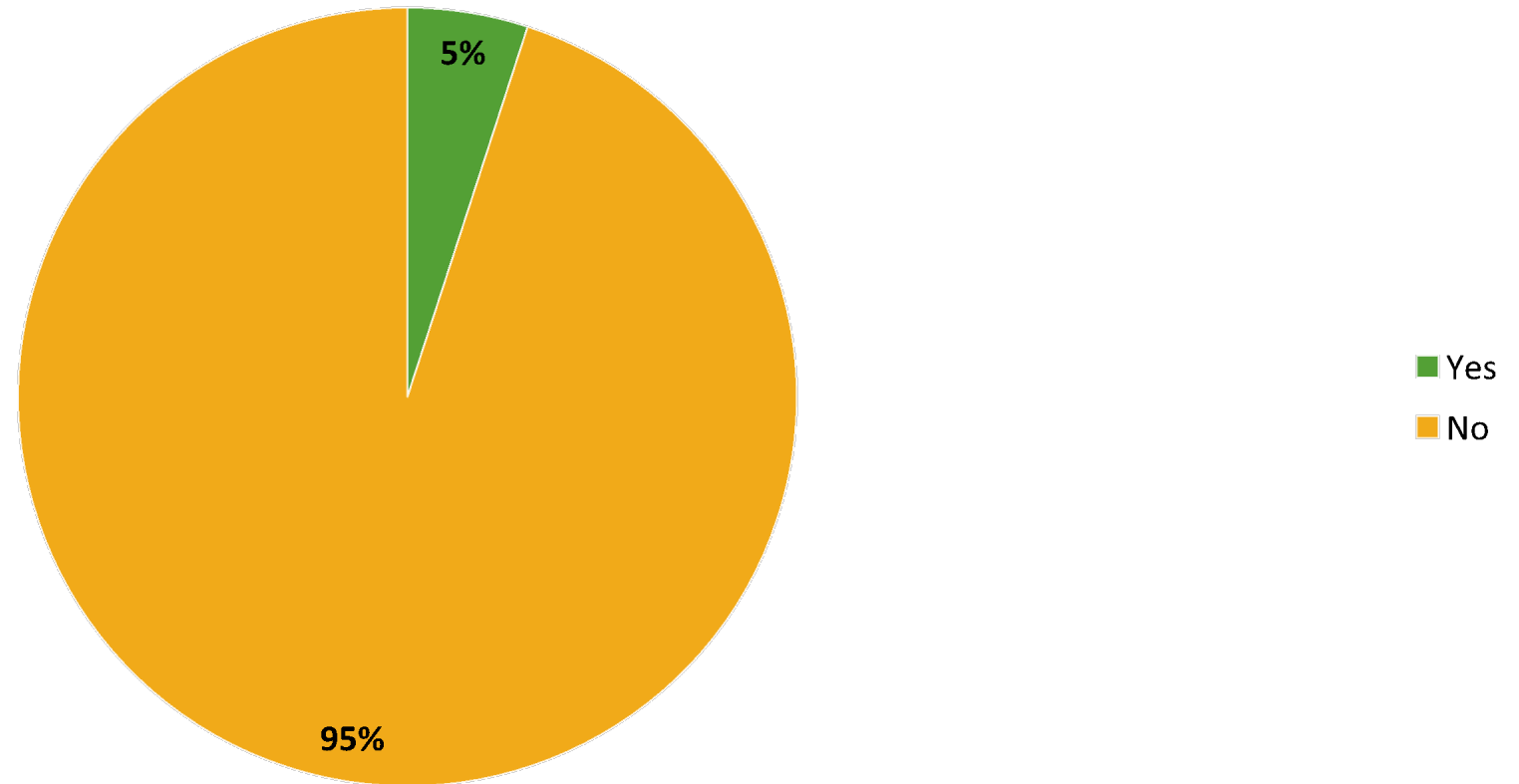
How do you prefer to receive information from your child's school? (N=365)

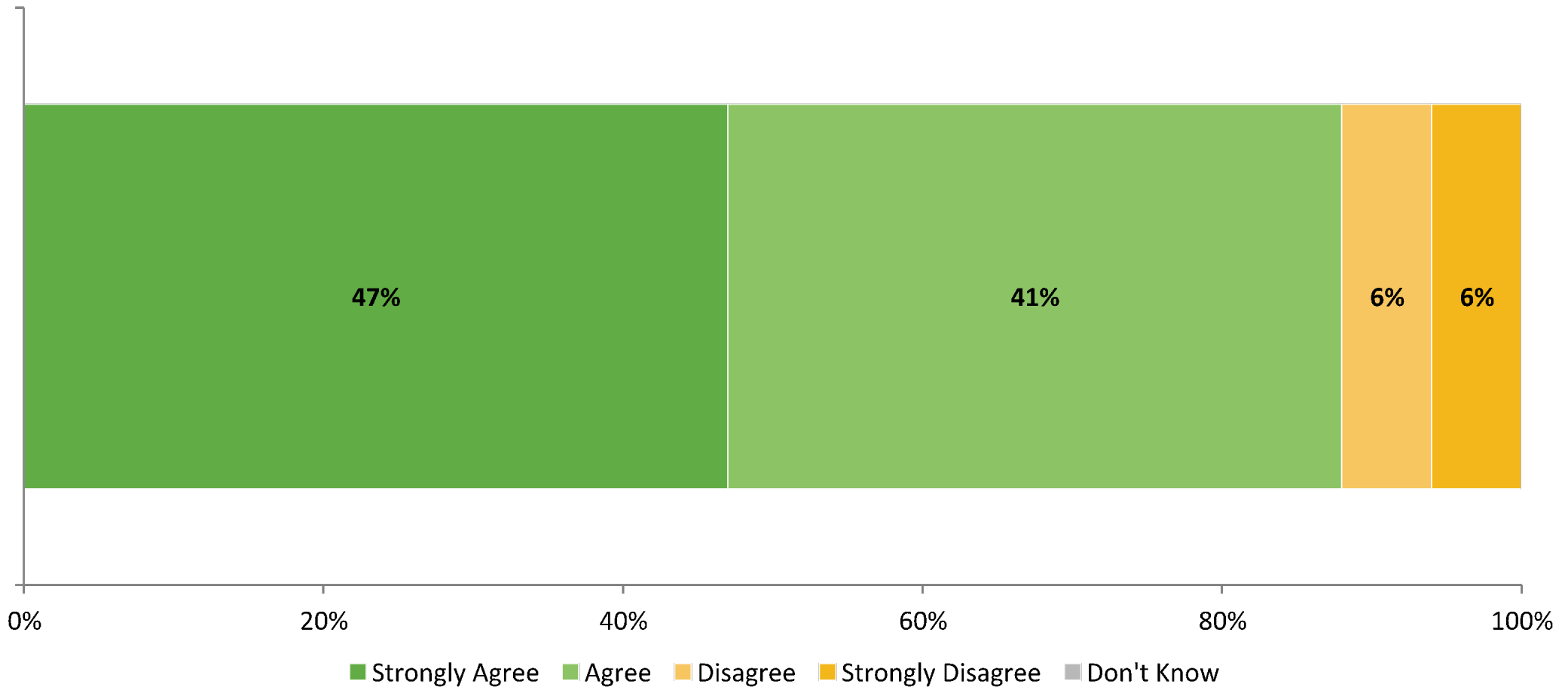

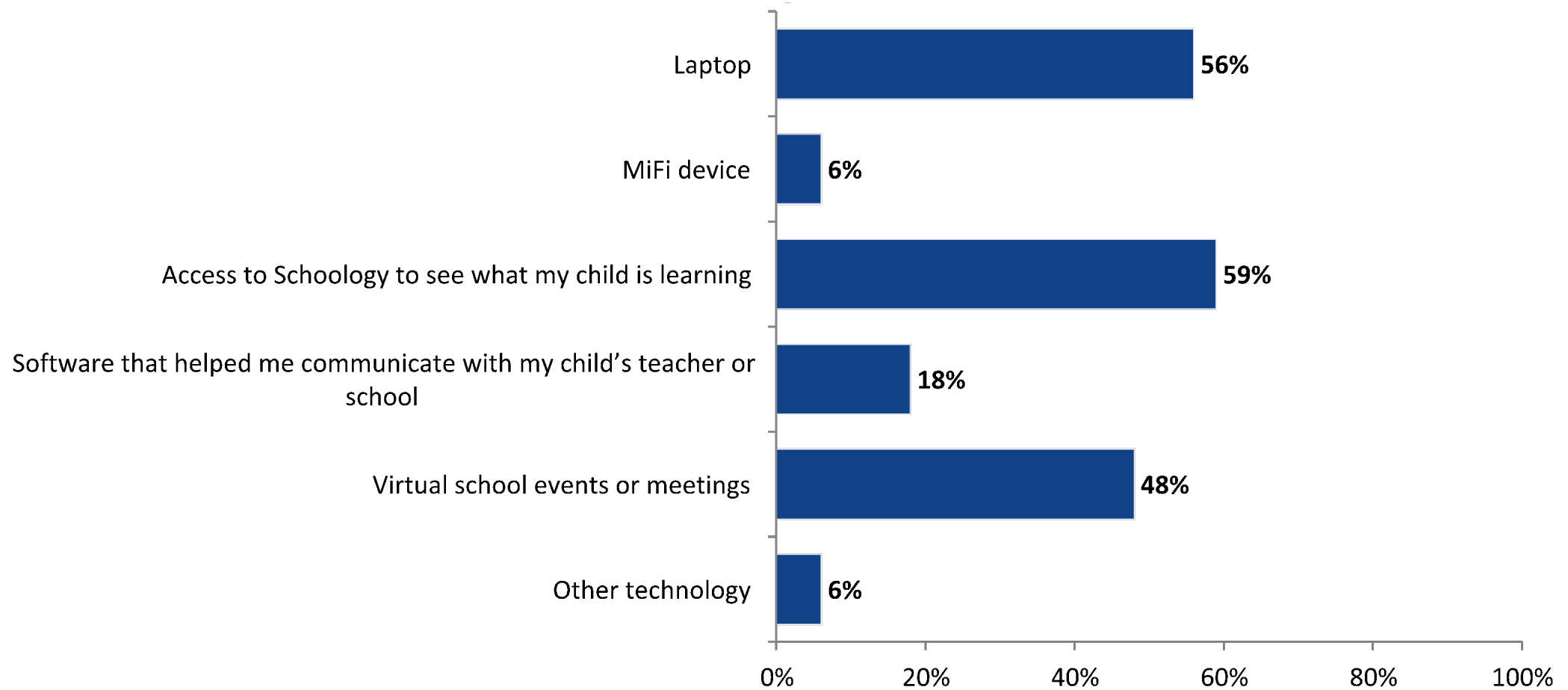

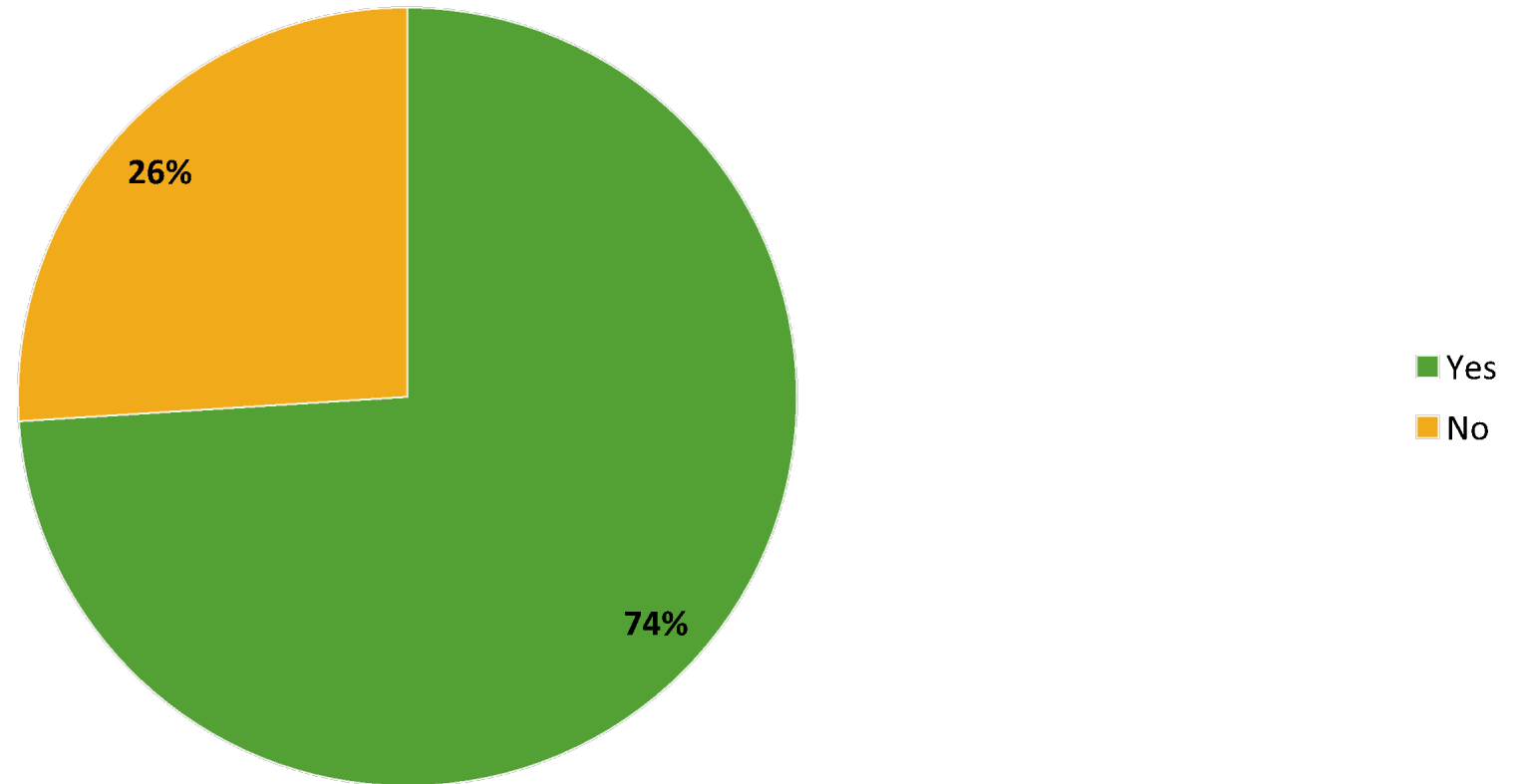
Which of the following helped you engage in your child's education? (N=336)

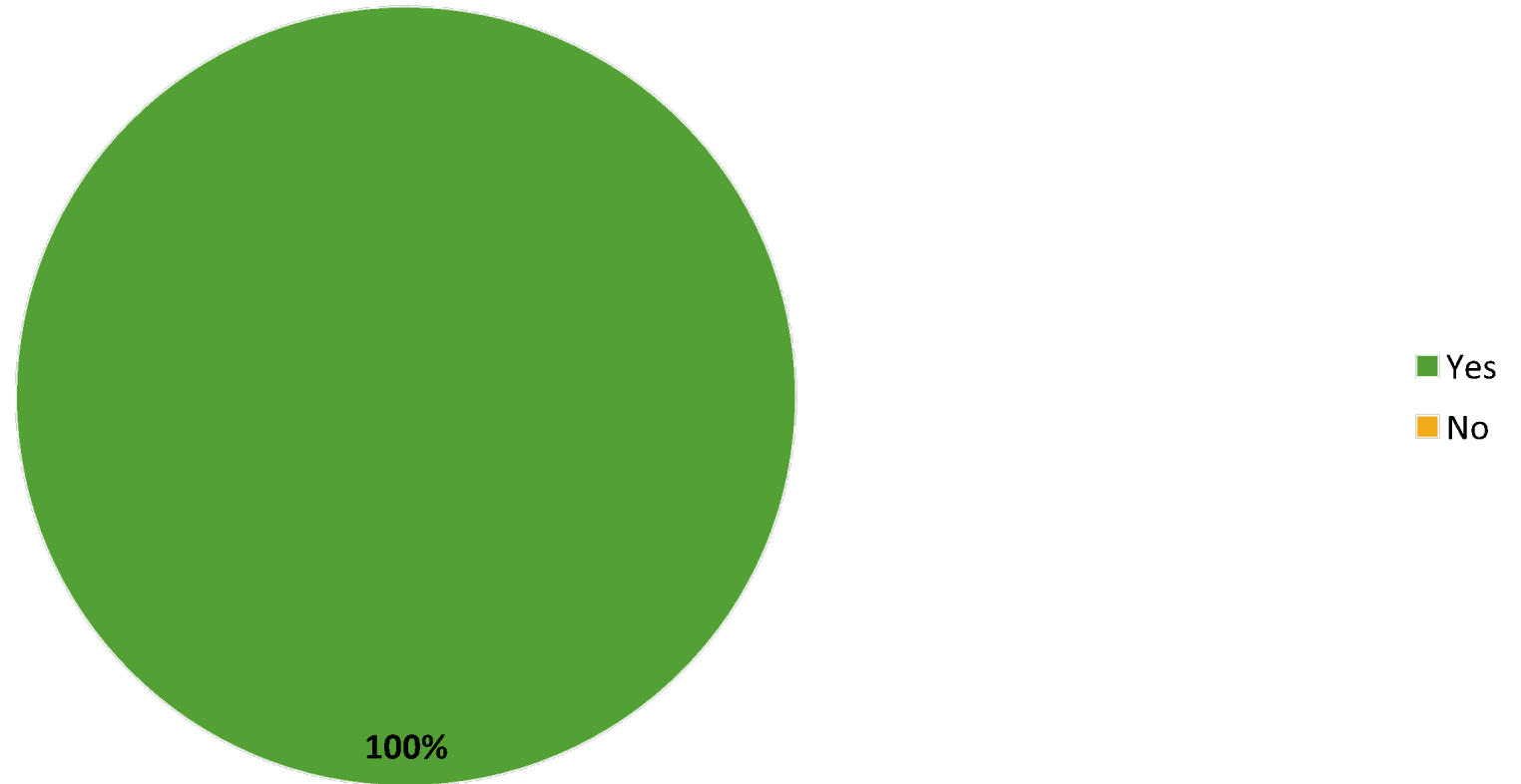
Thinking about your ability to engage in your child's education this school year, was your engagement improved by the availability of technology? (N=357)

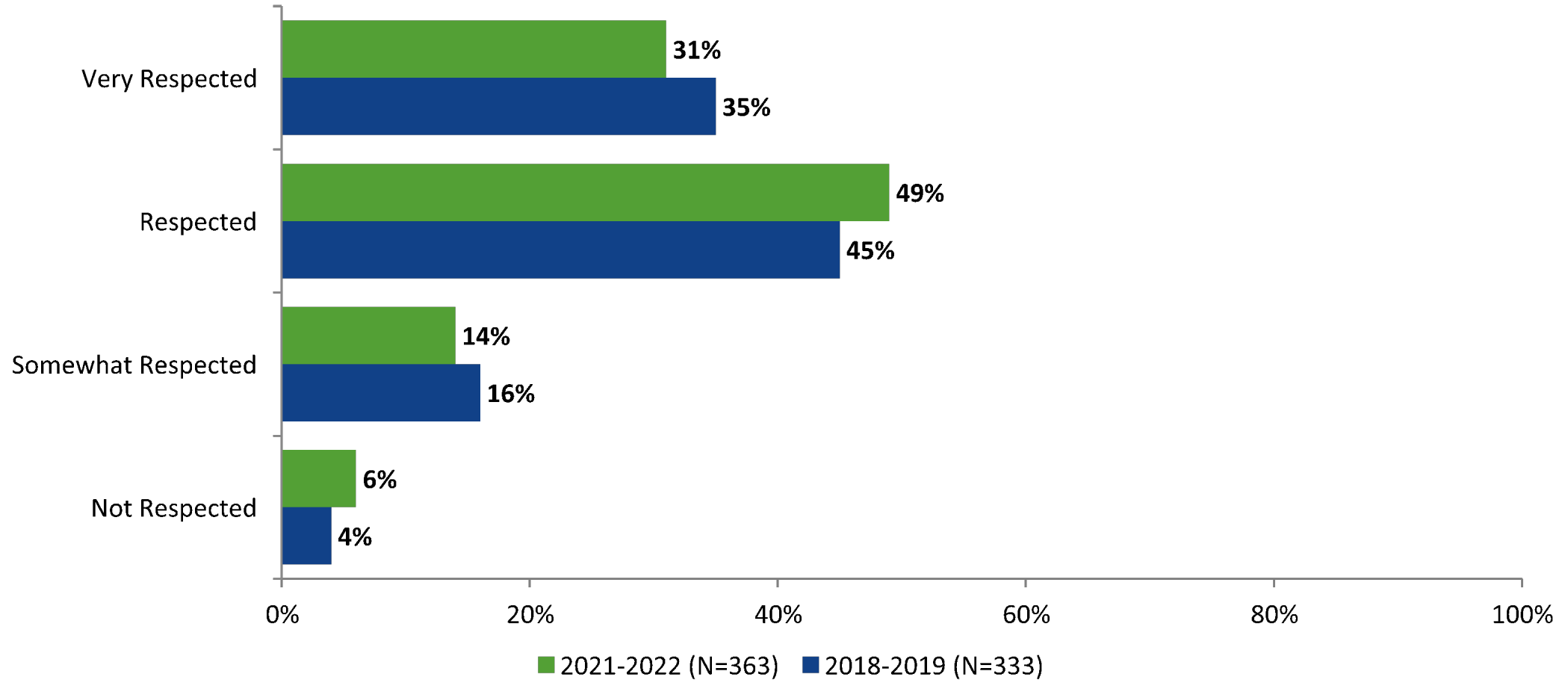

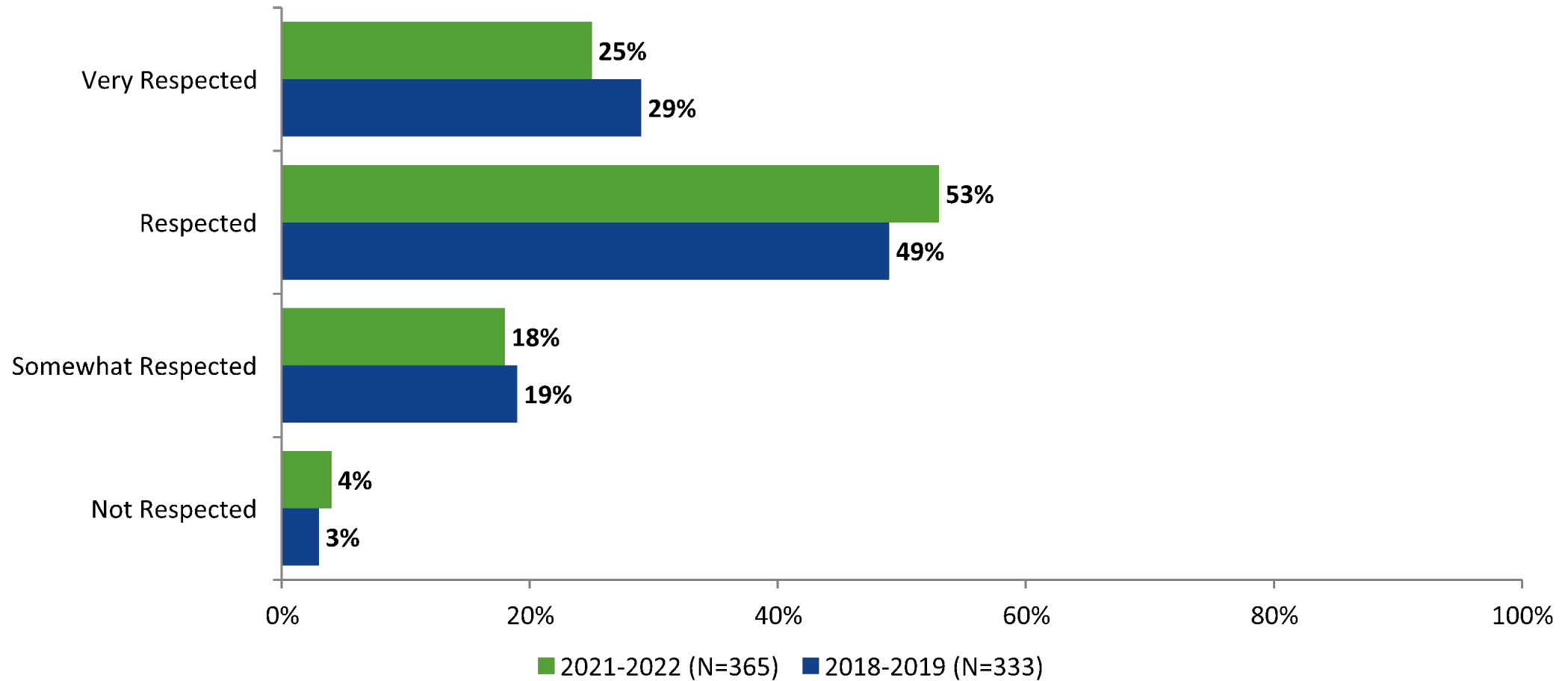
How respected do you feel at this school?



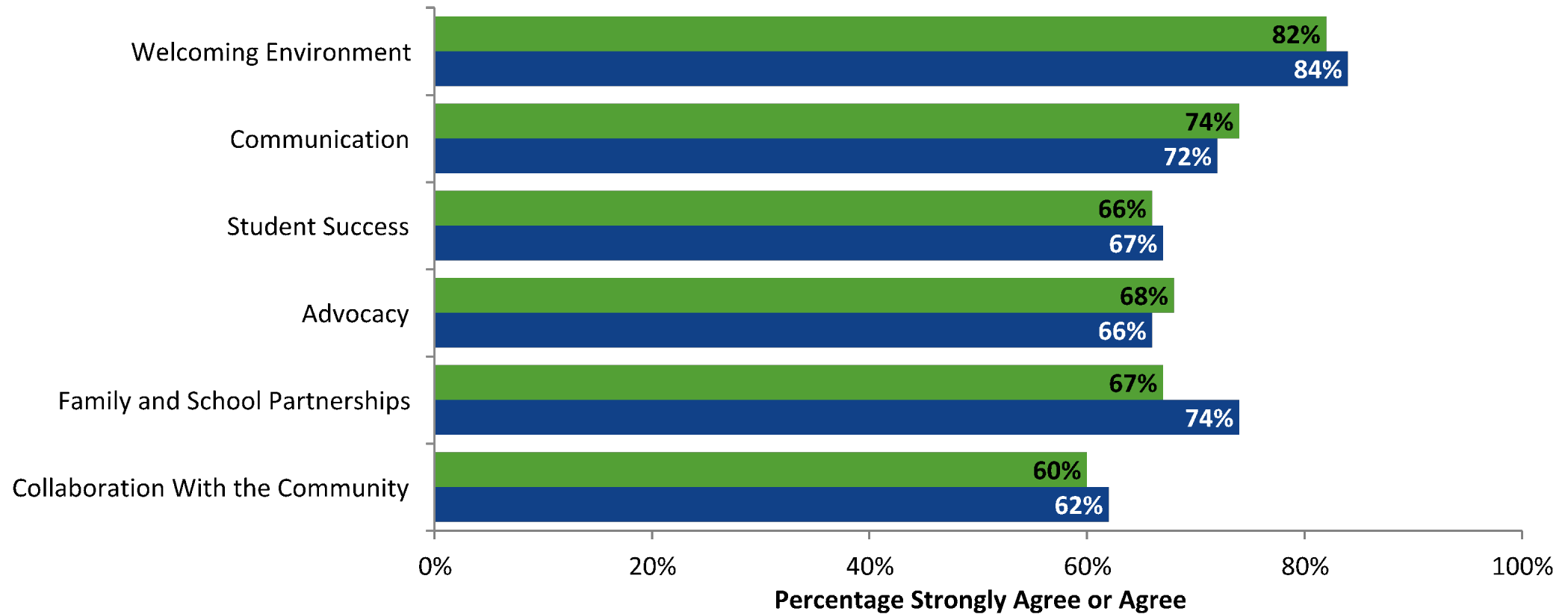

# Dimension Scores: Comparison Over Time



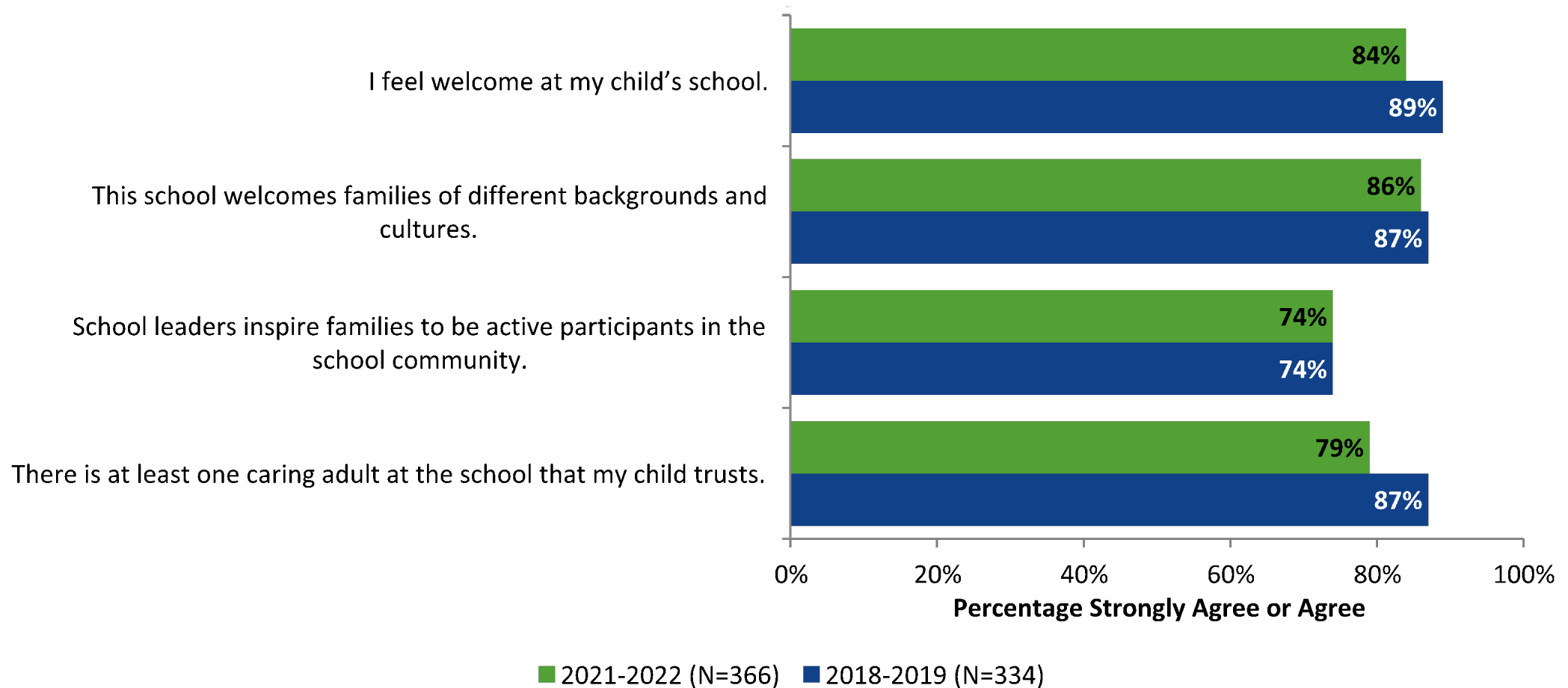

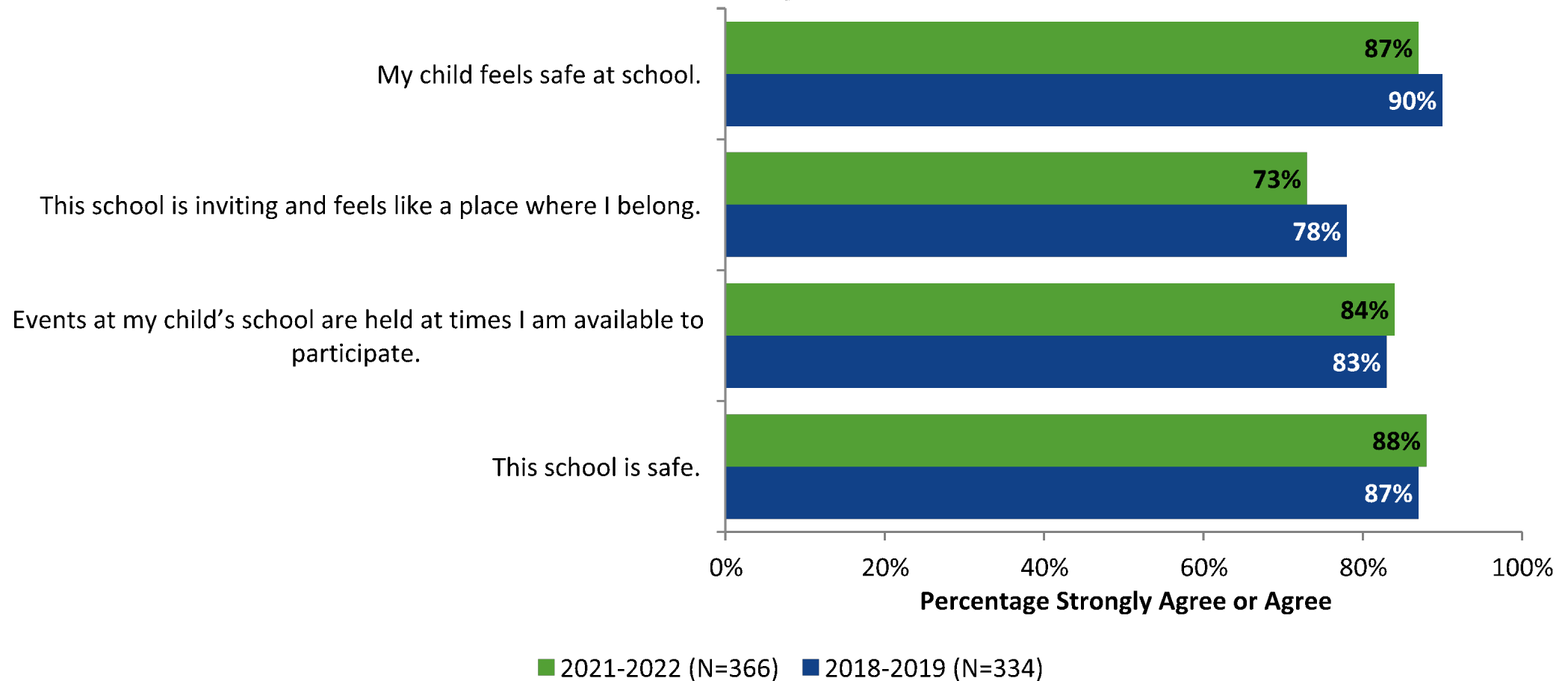

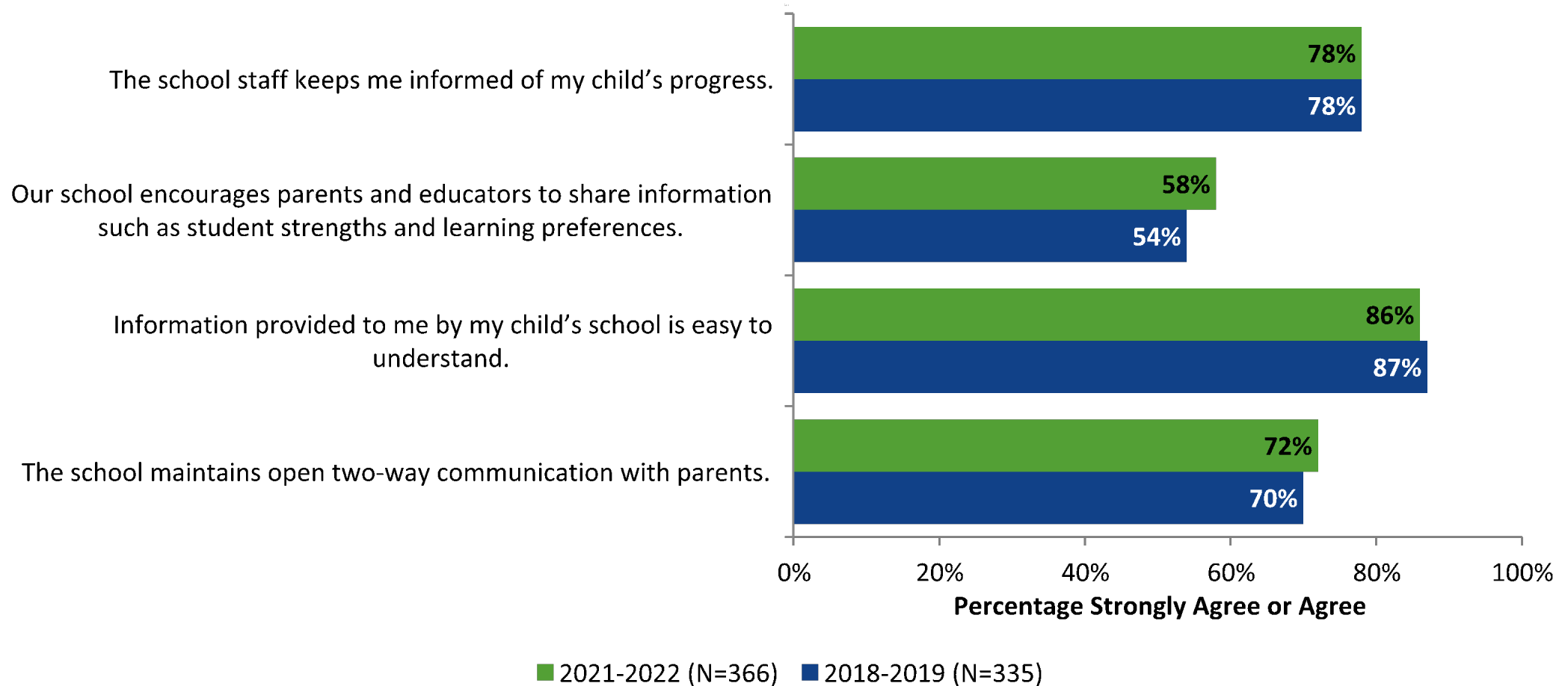

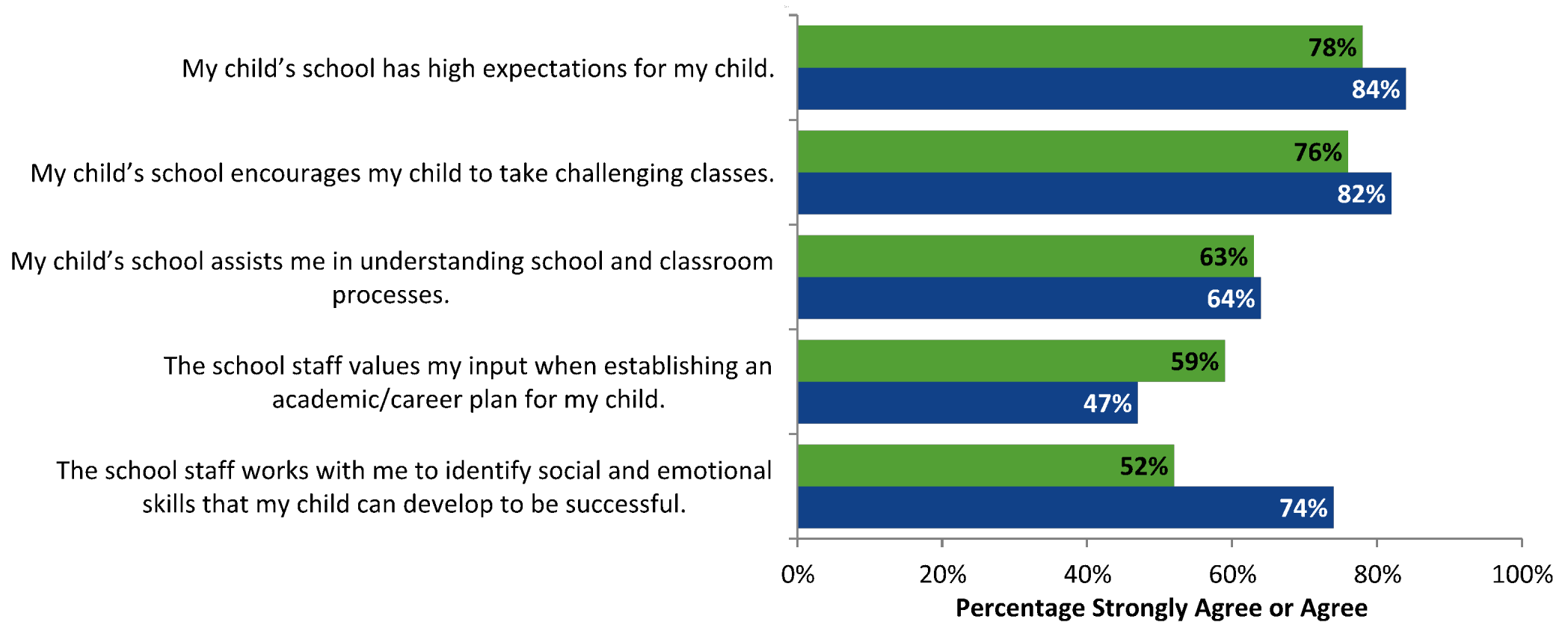
# Communication: Comparison Over Time

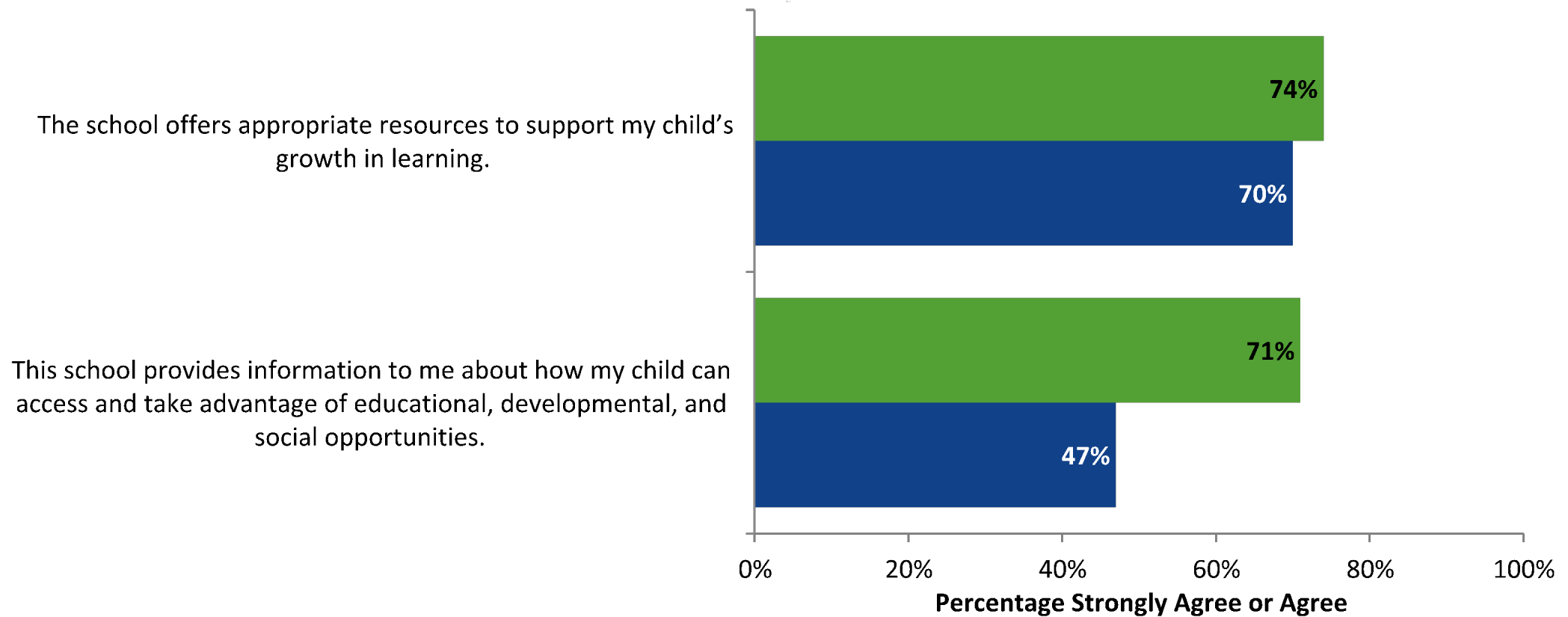

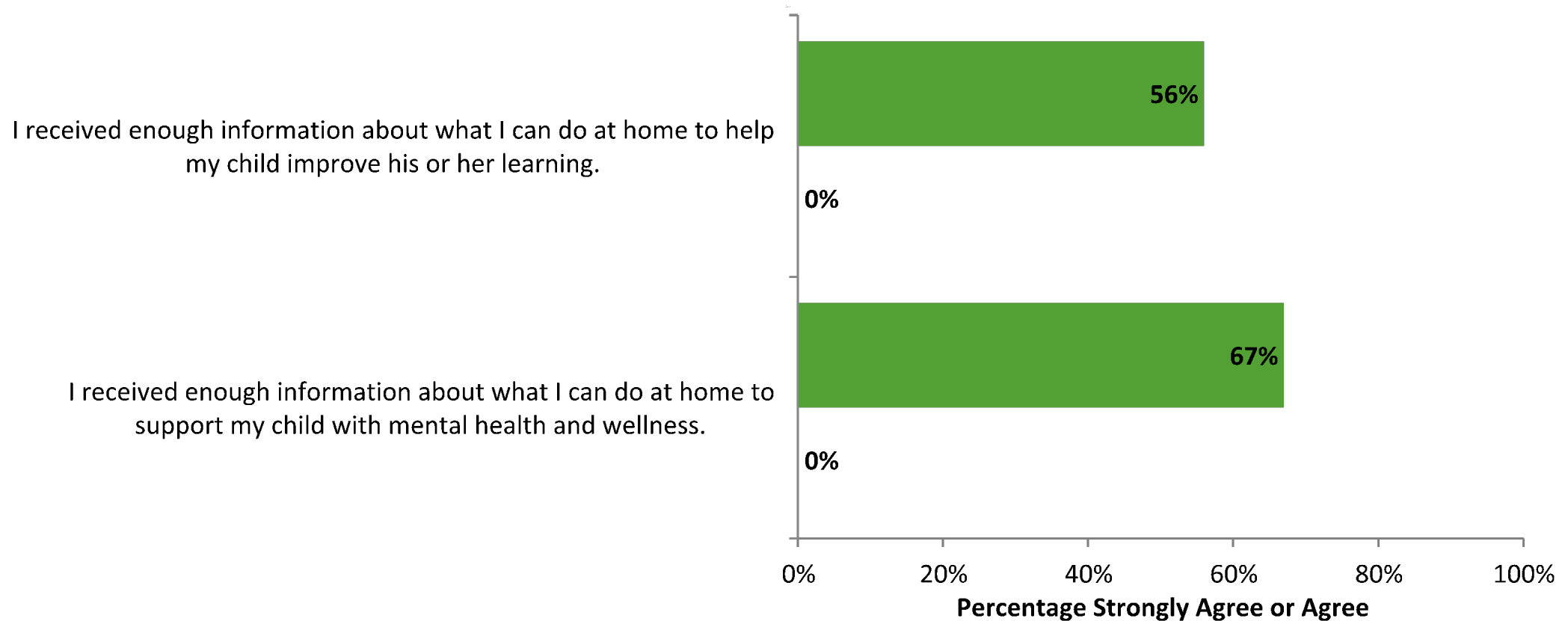

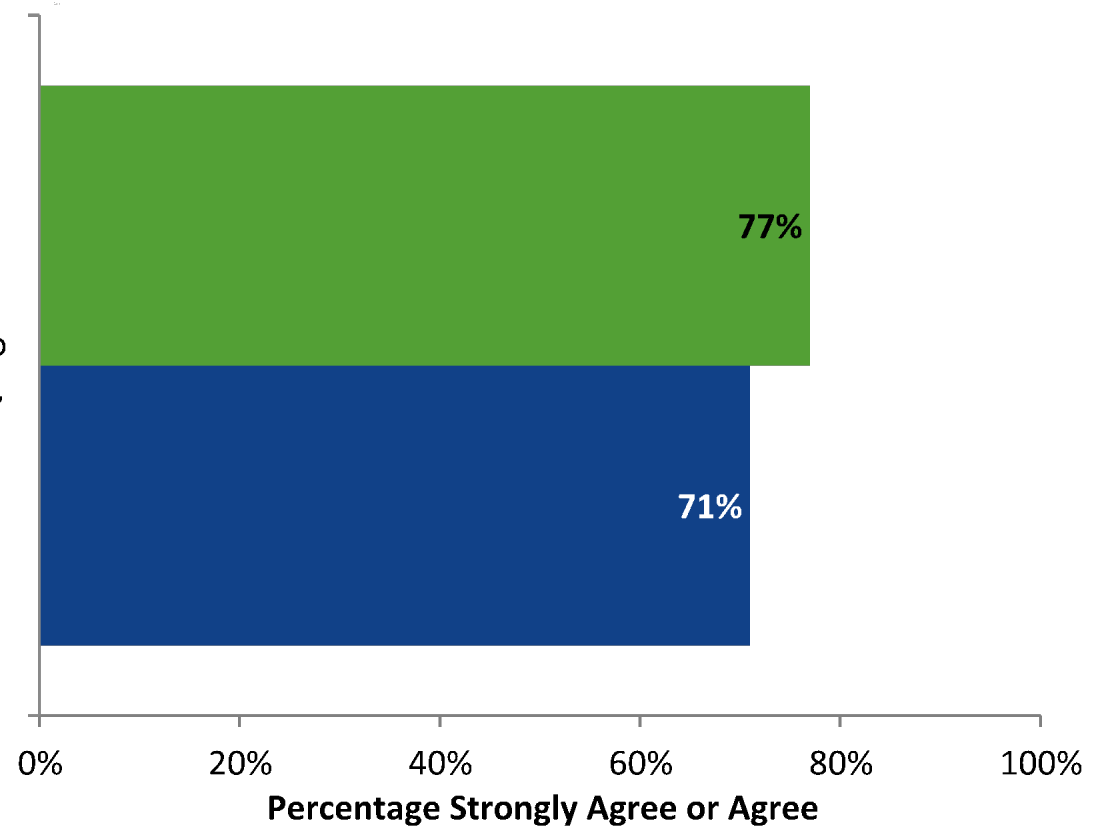

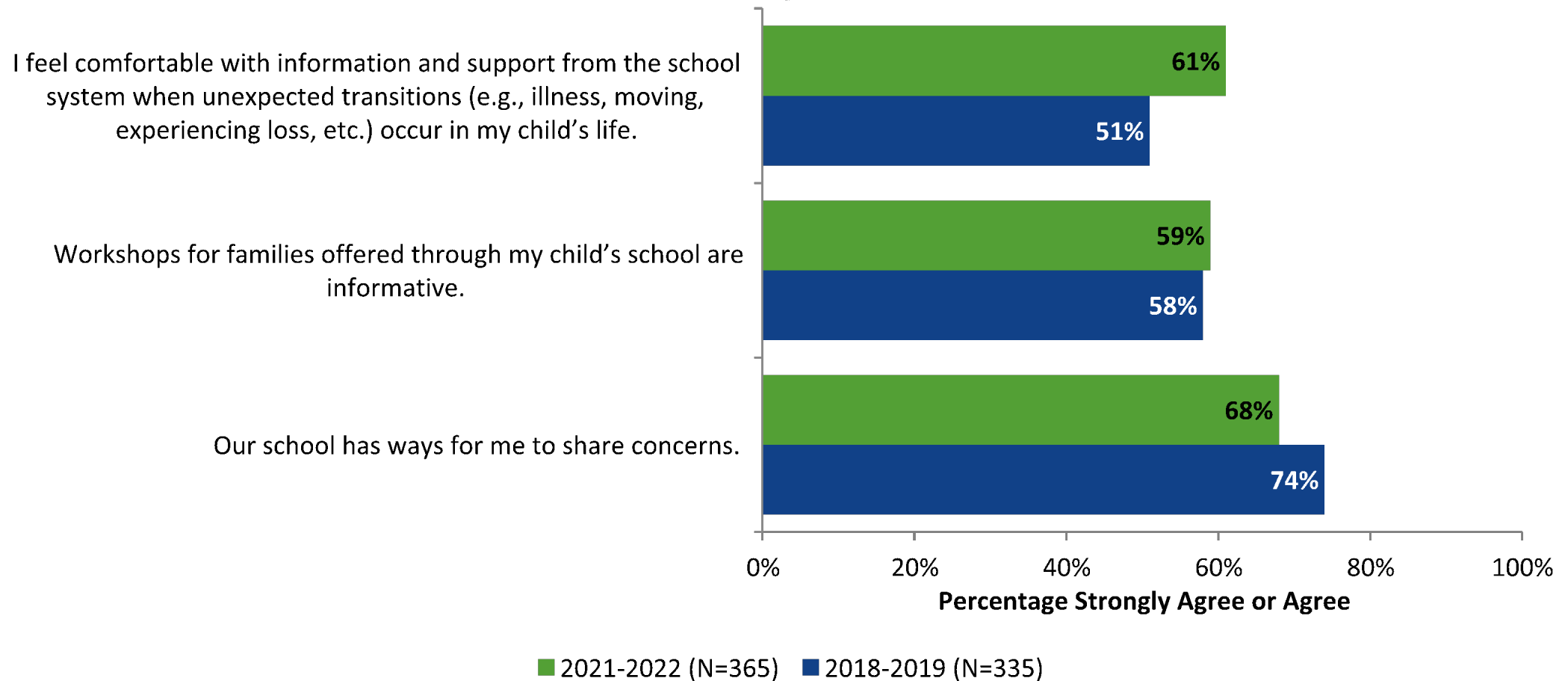

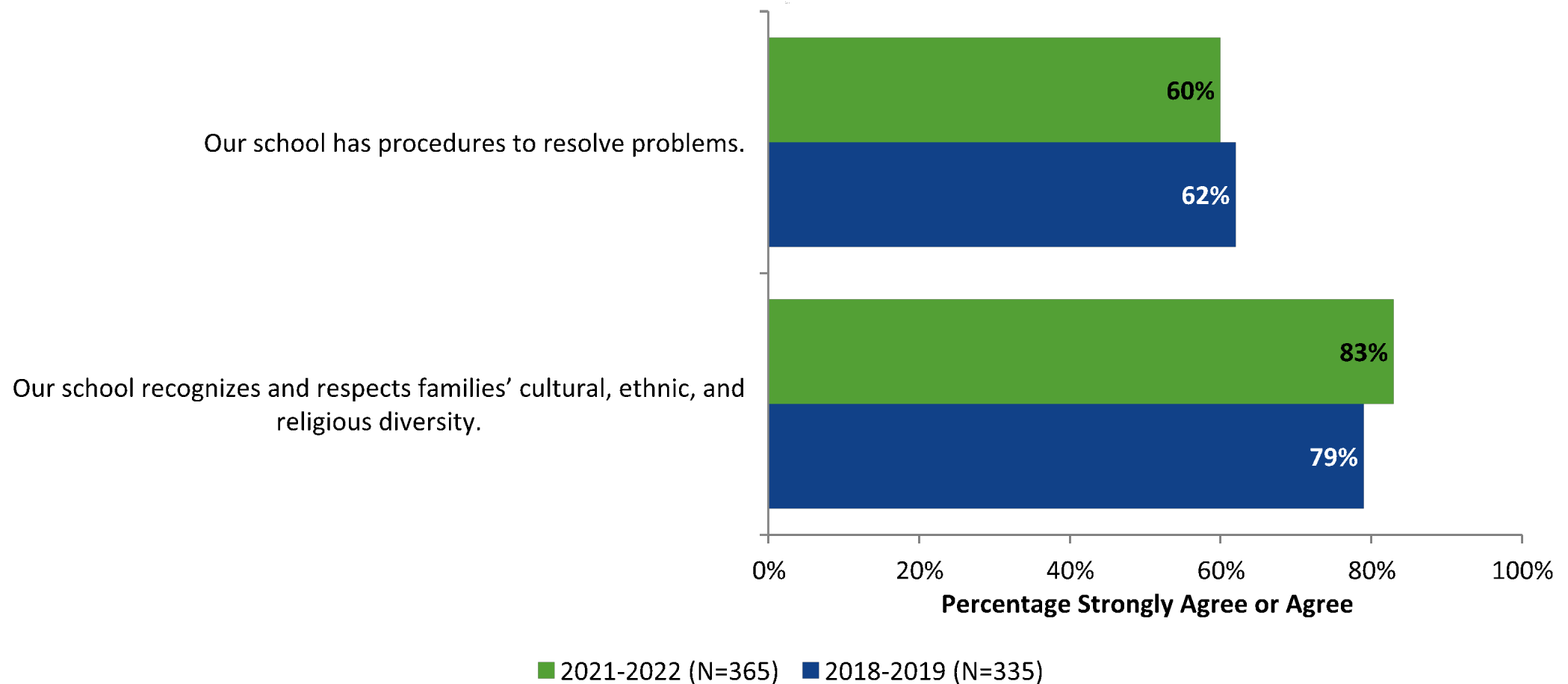

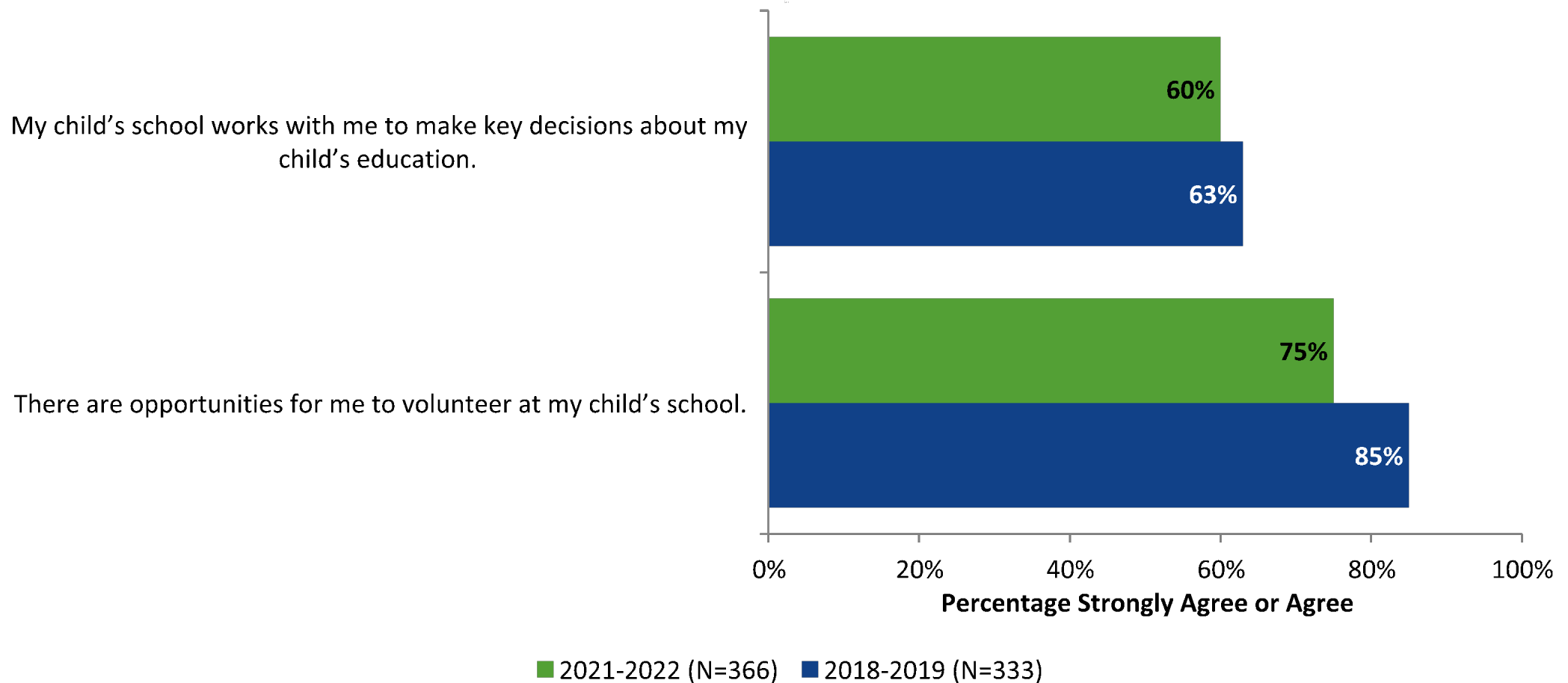

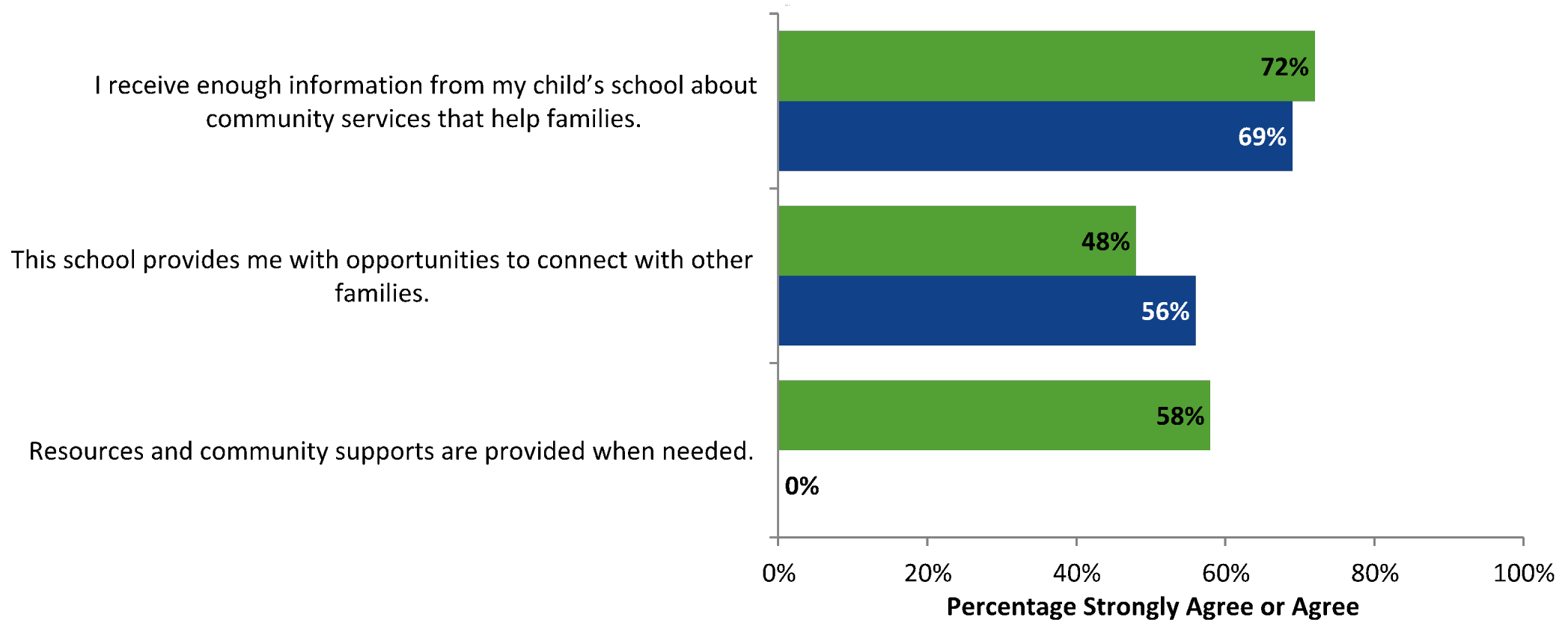
# Family and School Partnerships: Comparison Over Time

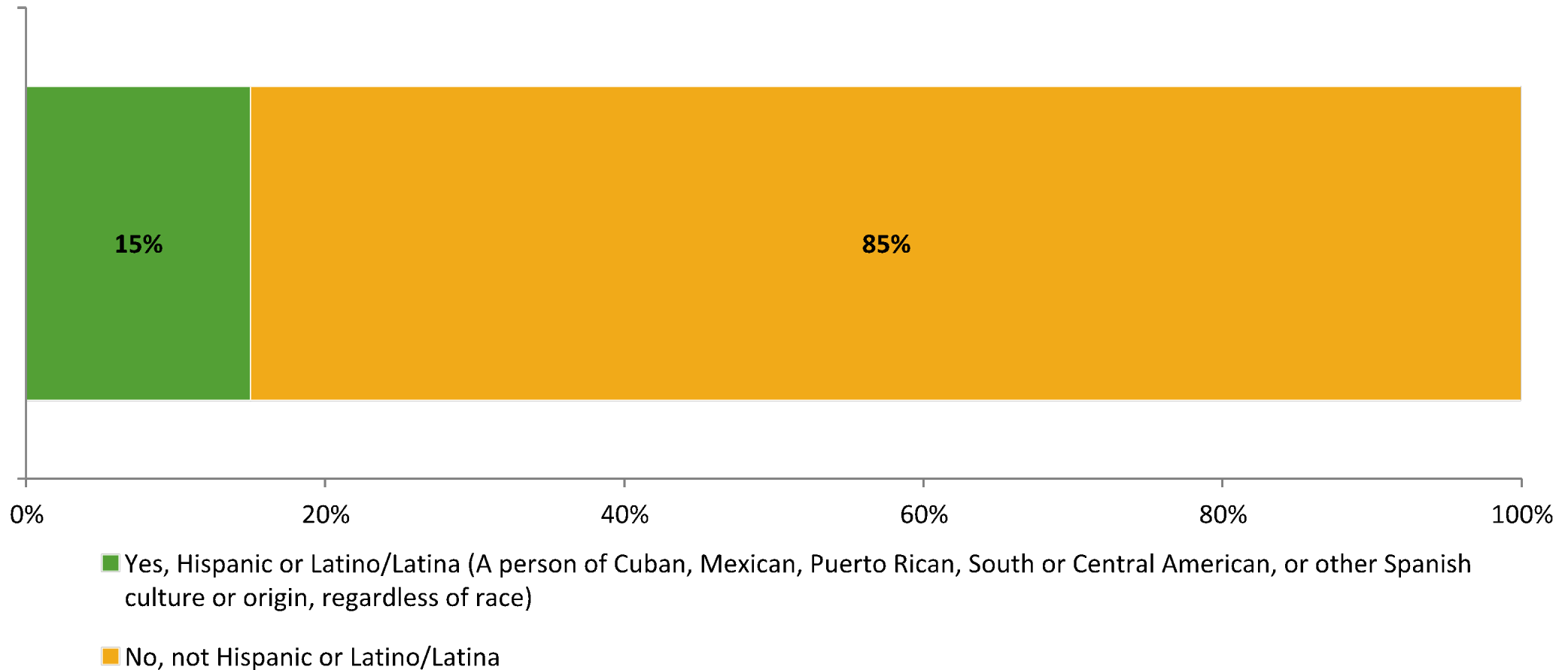

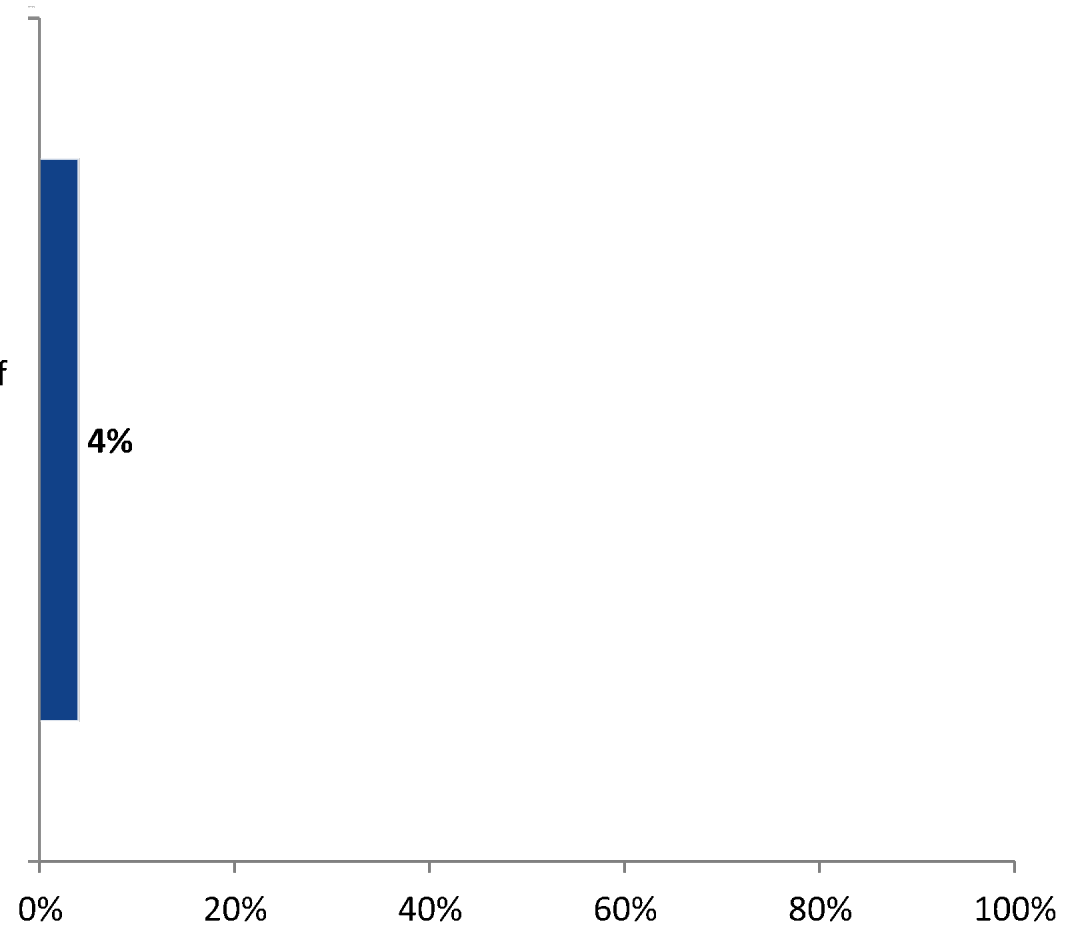

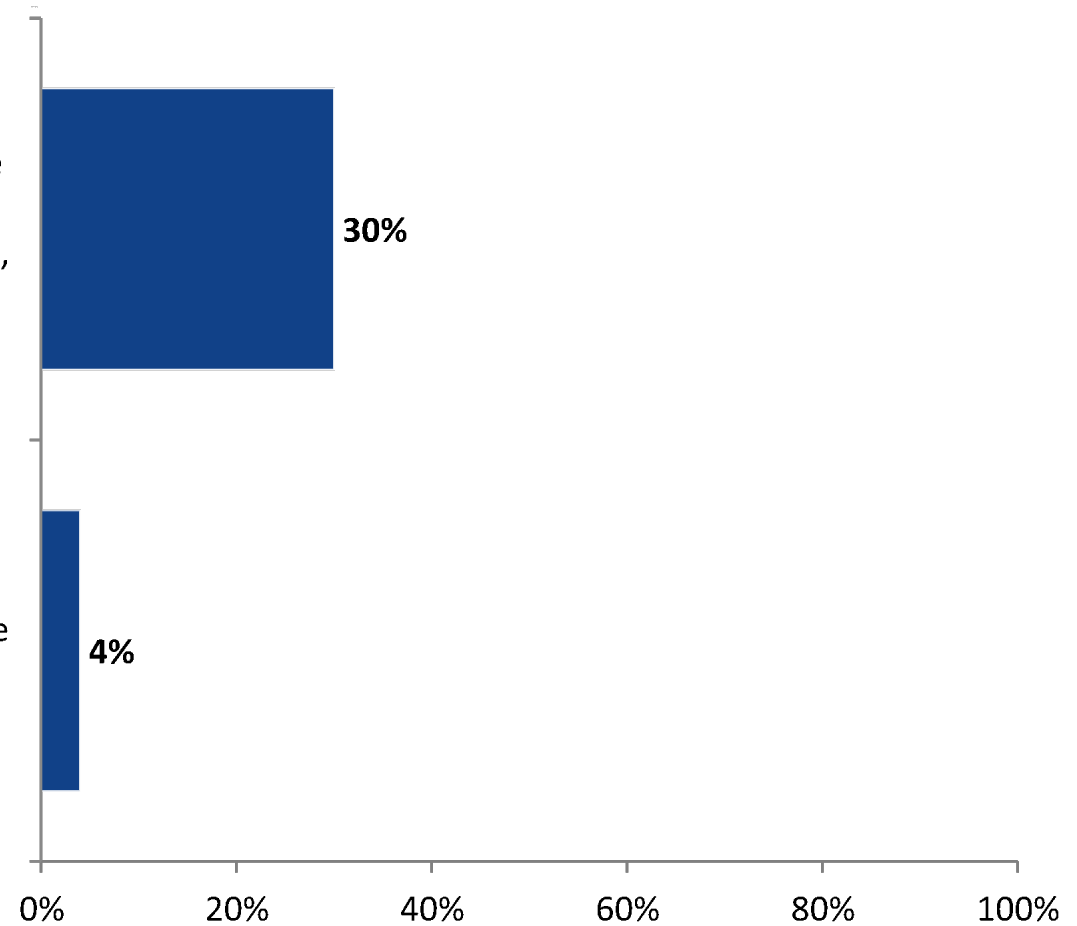

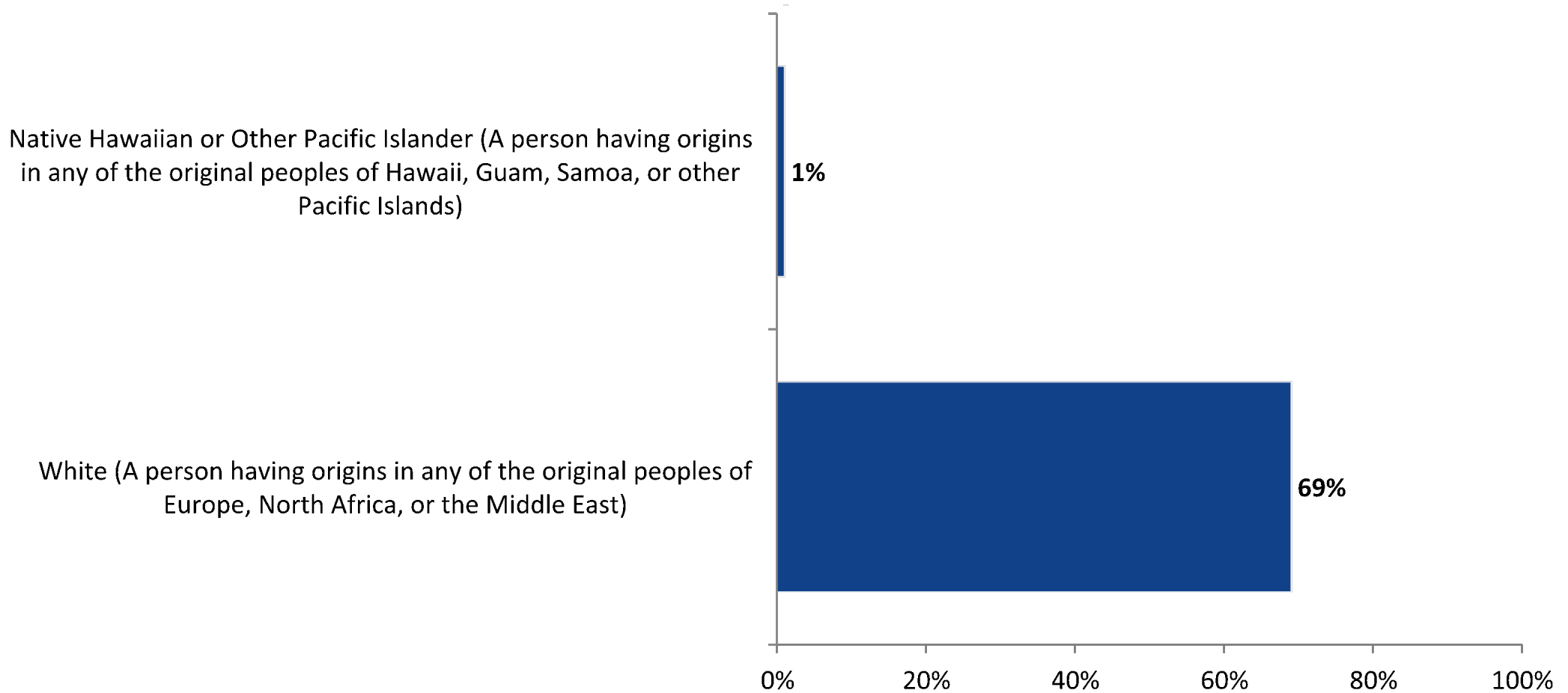

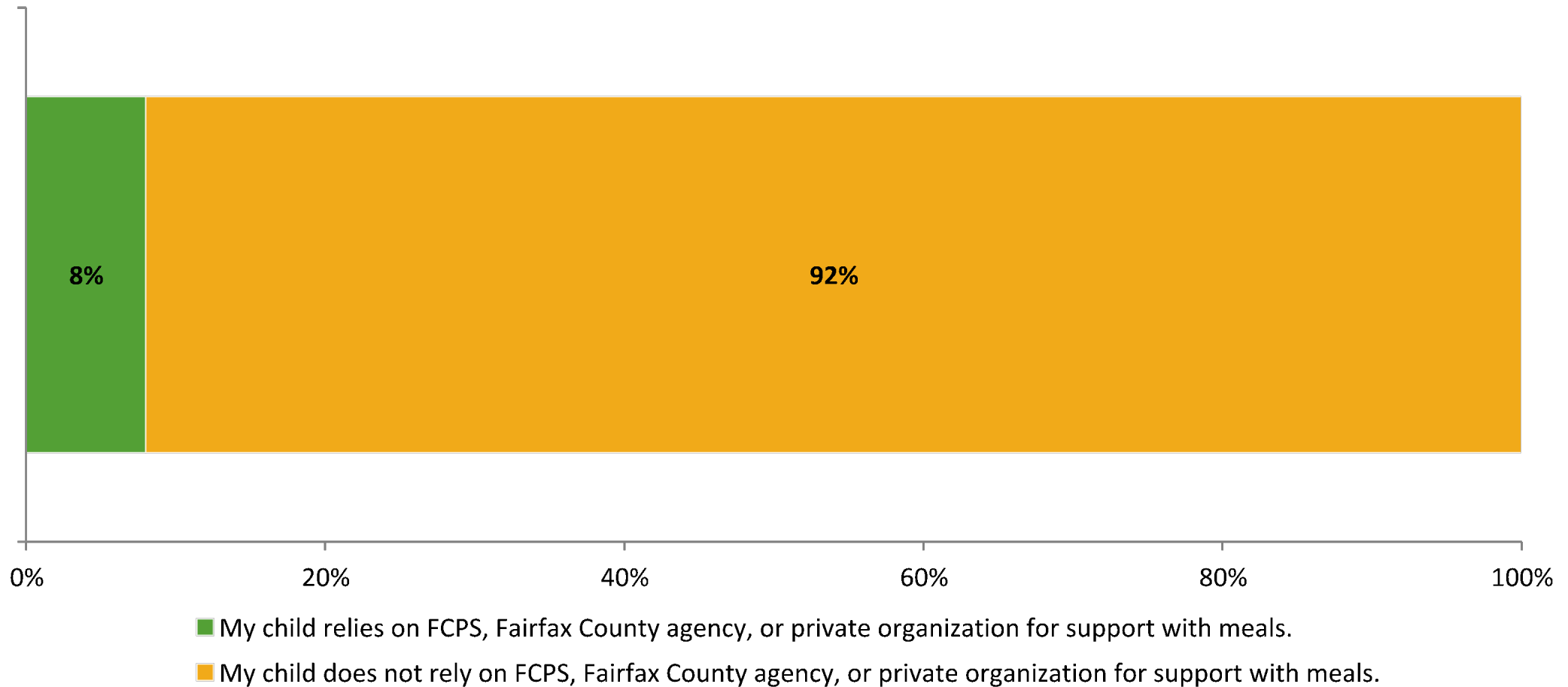

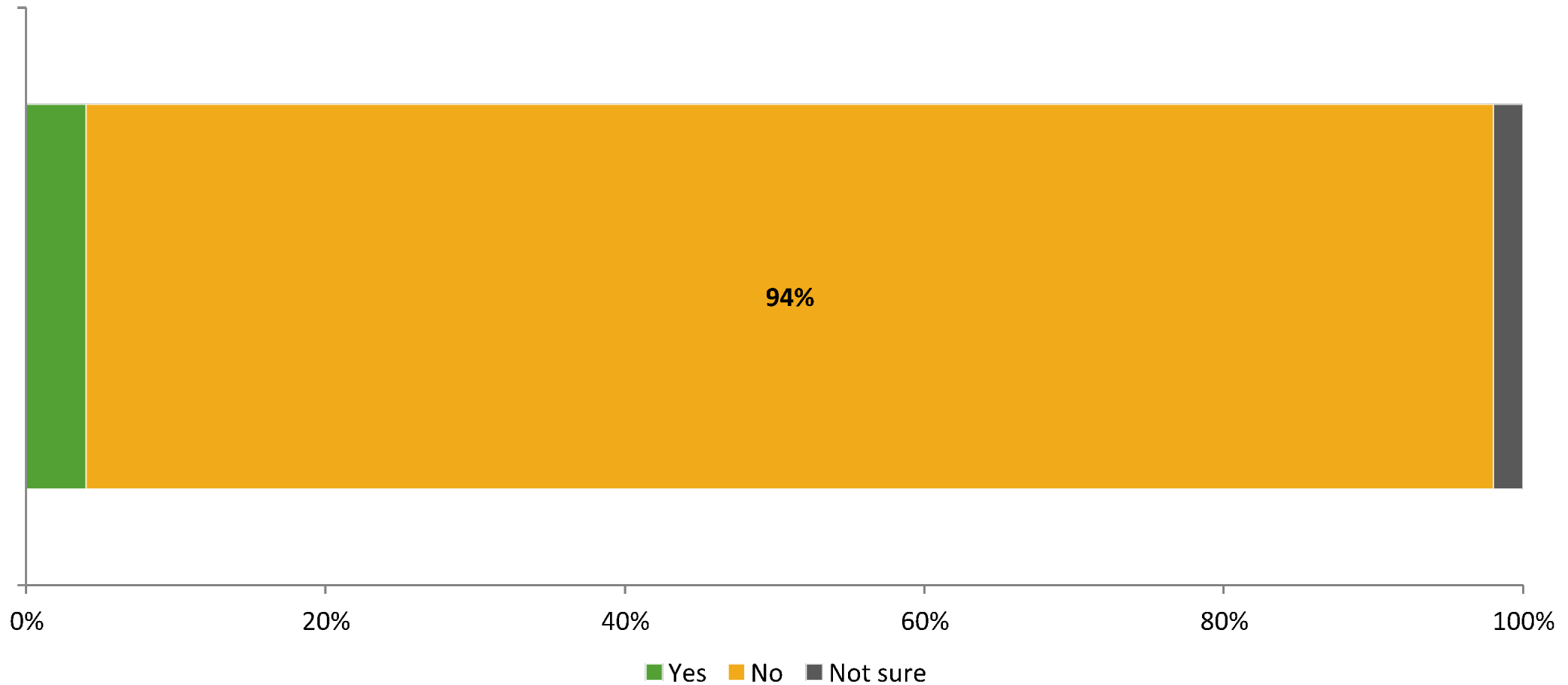

What best describes your child's food situation? (N=345)



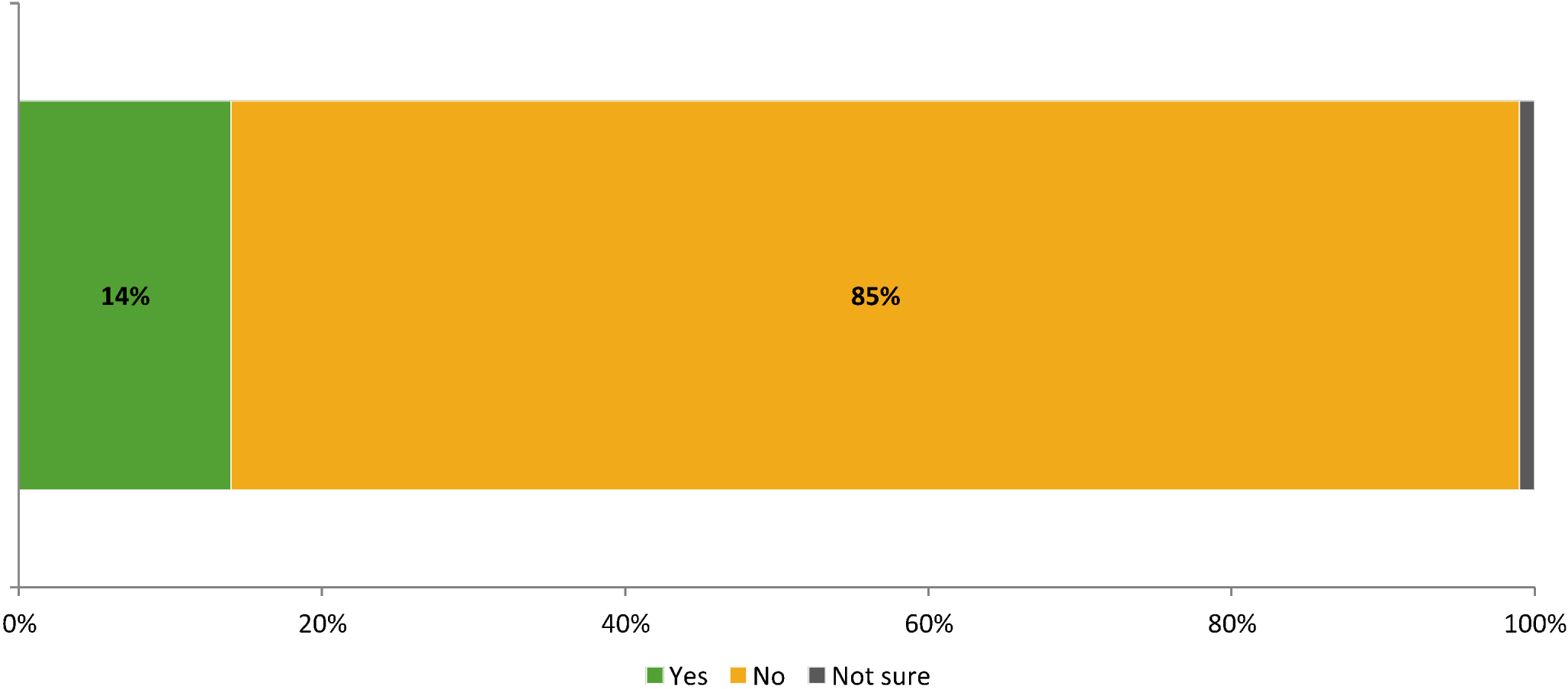
# English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) Services

Does your child receive English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) services? (N=353)



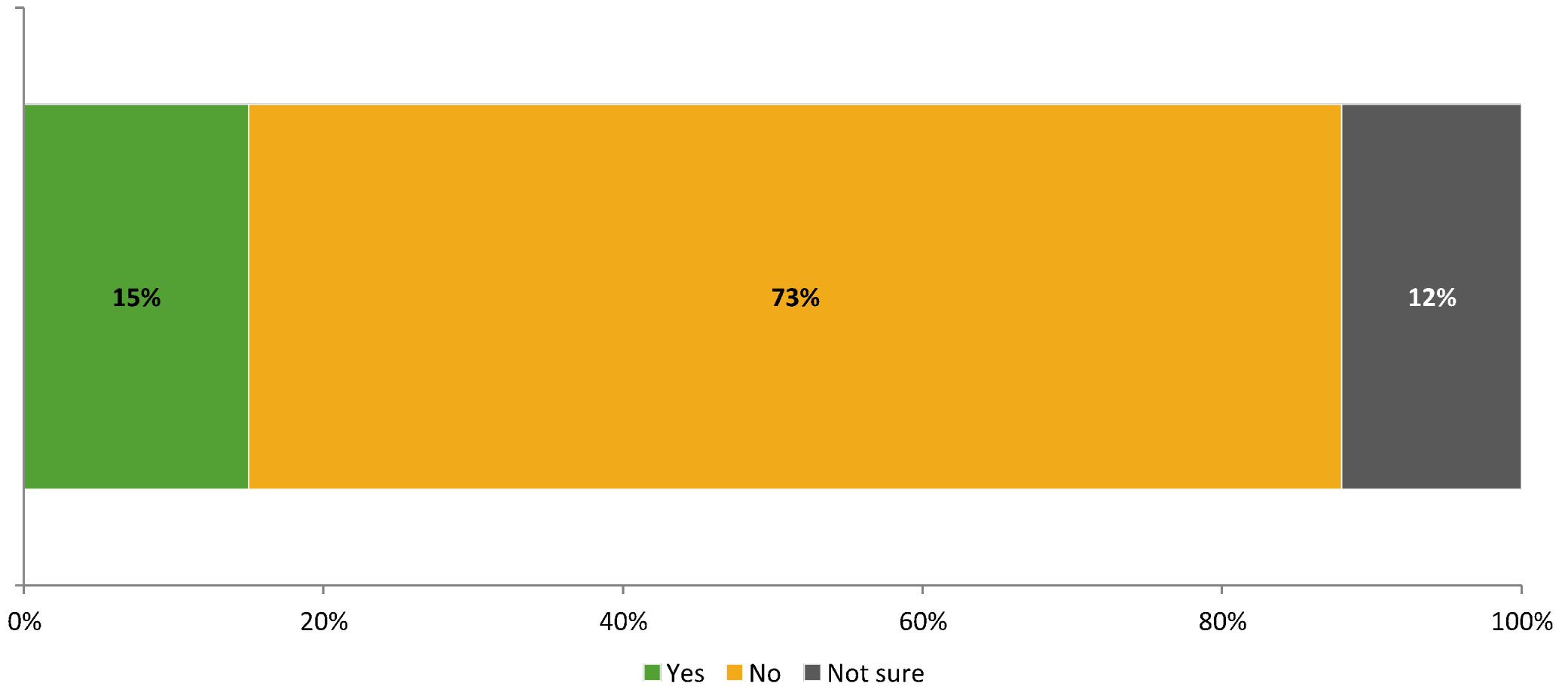
# Special Education Services

Does your child receive special education services? (N=353)



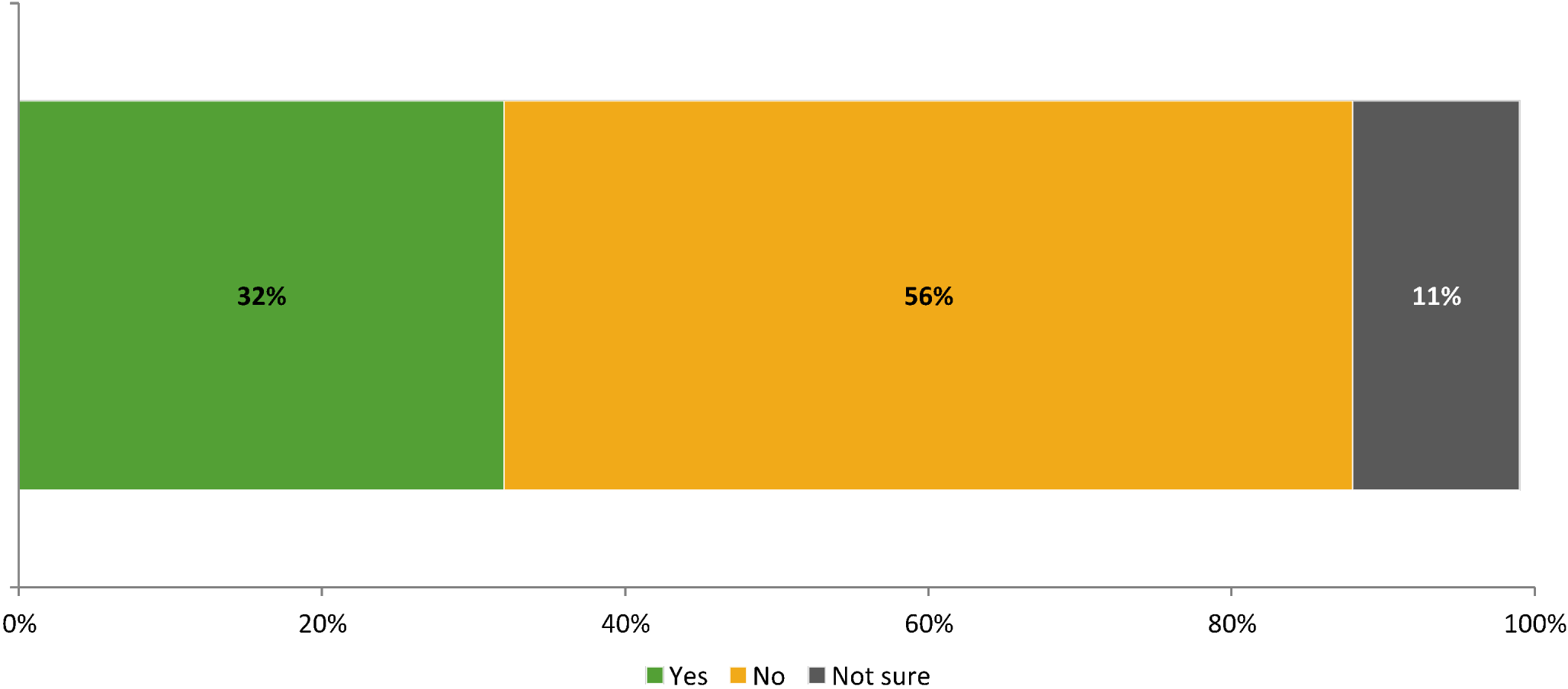
# 504 Plan Services
